



The highest district recorded by displacement incidents in the region was Borama district (1007).

In the incident resulting in the largest displacement, 660 individuals moved from Boon settlement due to Flood.

The second highest district recorded by displacement incidents in the region was Baki district (36).

In the incident resulting in the second largest displacement, 41 individuals moved from Qolqol settlement due to Drought.


