# Participatory Assessment 2022

**Focus:** intentions and local integration (education, access to medical assistance, access to employment and social services, community cohesion)

**Timeframe for data collection:** October 11 – November 2

**Partners involvement:** CDA, CCR, MPP, INTERSOS, National Congress of Ukrainians in Moldova, Genderdoc-M, Roma-led organizations, Casa Marioarei and others

# Participatory Assessment 2022

## Geographical coverage:

- Both urban and rural areas

## Accommodation types:

- Refugees' accommodation centres
- Host families
- Private accommodation



# Participatory Assessment 2022

- People with Disabilities;
- Elderly people 65+;
- Roma refugees;
- Adults;
- LGBTIQ;
- Non-Ukrainian refugees and asylum seekers;
- Teenagers and youth people;
- Stateless people;

# Participatory Assessment 2022

**Total number of FGDs:** 43 + 1 semi-structured dialog

**Total number of participants:** 342

- 73% female
- 27% male

# Participatory Assessment 2022

## Findings\_People with disabilities:

### Main highlights:

- Need for inclusion in the labour market for PwDs
- Concerns regarding exclusion of men from the assistance programmes
- Need of winter items to cope the cold period

### Intentions:

- Proximity to Ukraine and common language
- Overall positive interaction with the local community
- Return to Ukraine once the war is over
- Only in one case the possibility of travel to Germany for medical reason is considered

# Participatory Assessment 2022

## Findings\_People with disabilities:

### Housing:

- Private accommodation vs RACs (not adequate facilities)

### Access to medical assistance:

- Overall positive experience (Russian-speaking Doctors)
- People accommodated in private accommodation had limited access to information regarding medicines distribution
- Concerns regarding the high cost of medicines and their unavailability in Moldova
