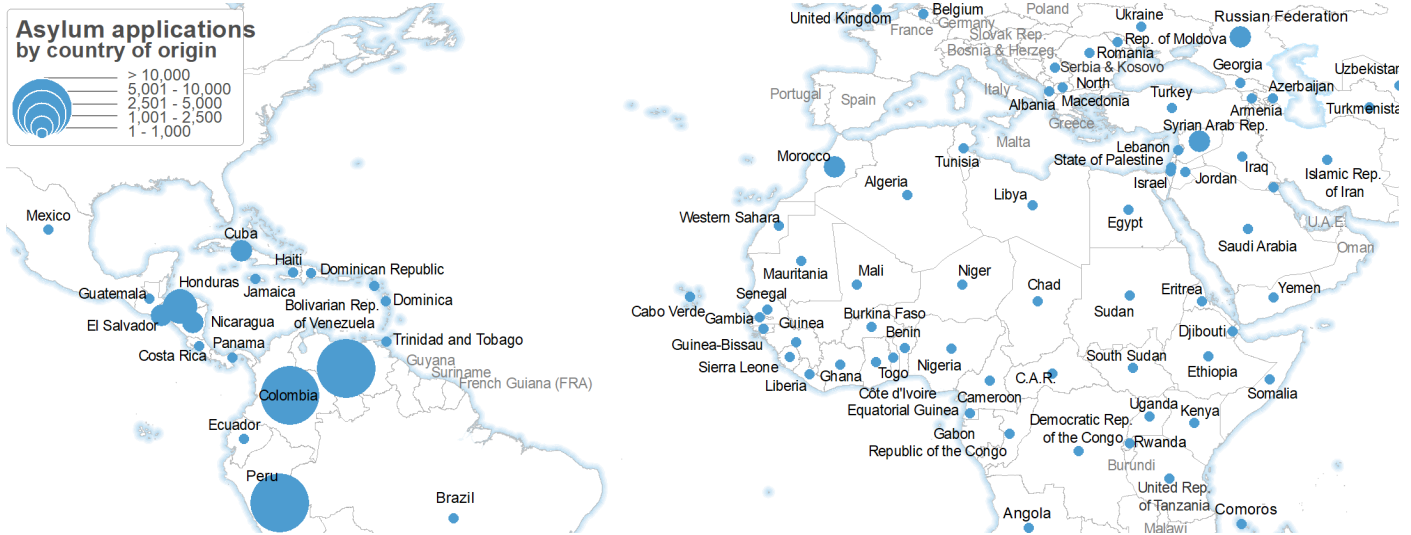

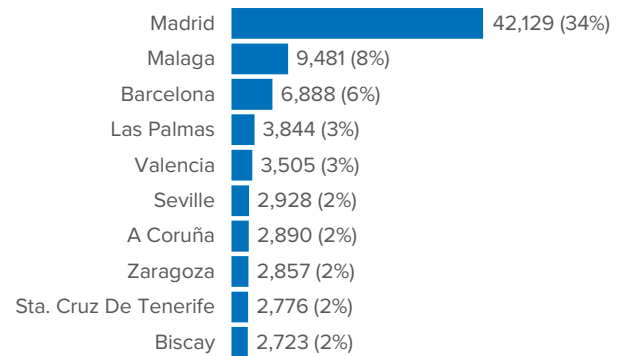
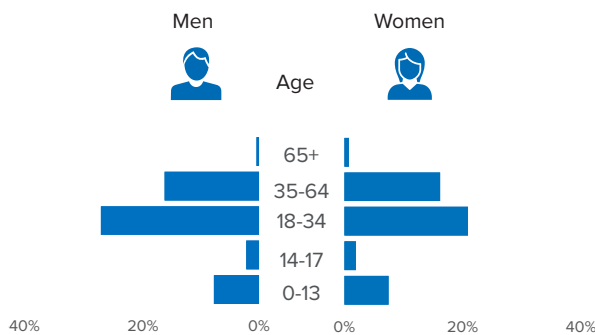

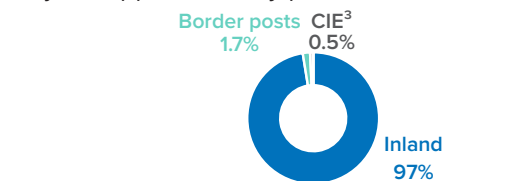
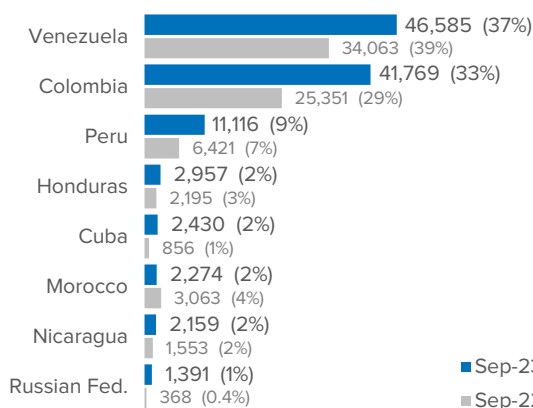
Number of asylum applications by gender/age²

Asylum applications by place of submission



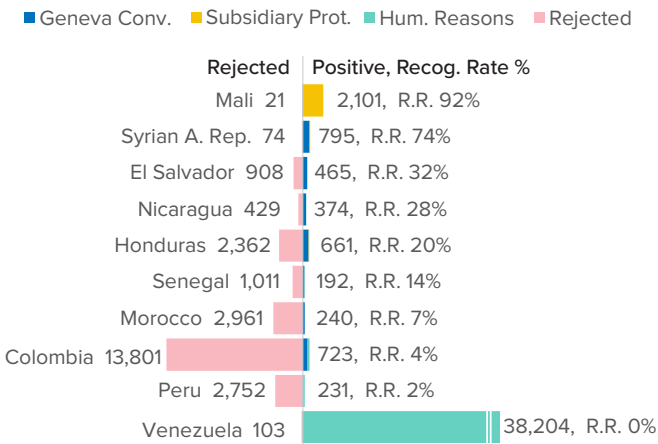
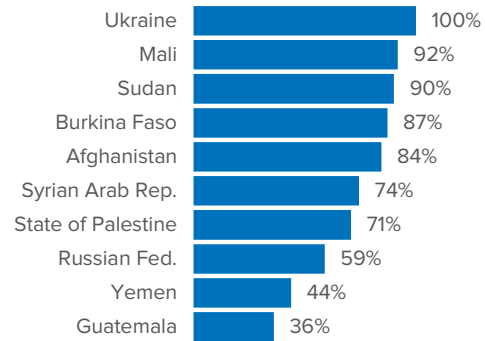
Asylum applications per month



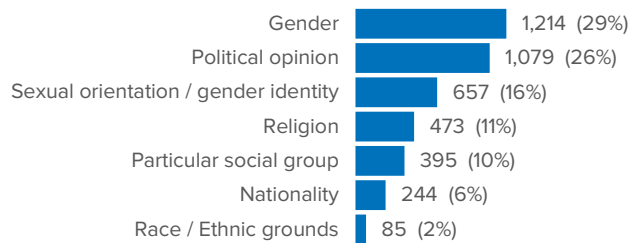

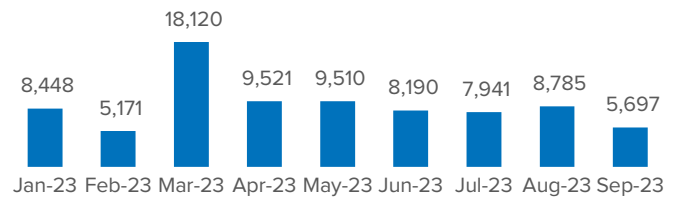

Eligibility Commission proposals per month



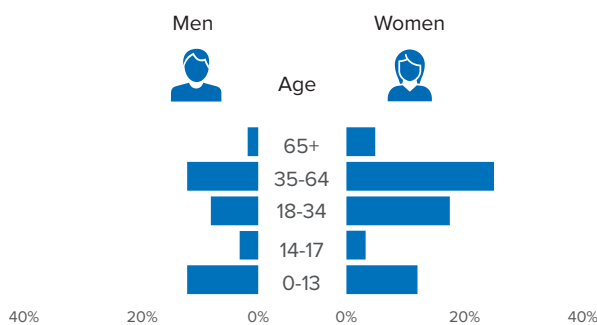

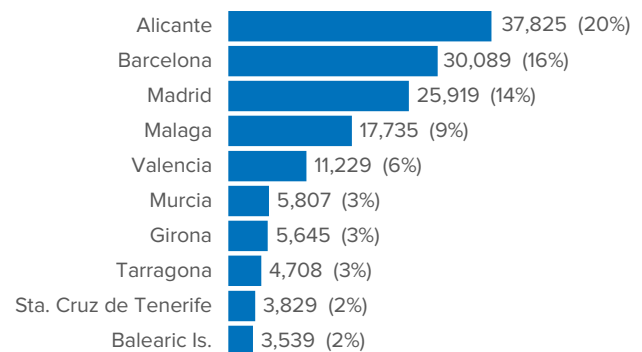

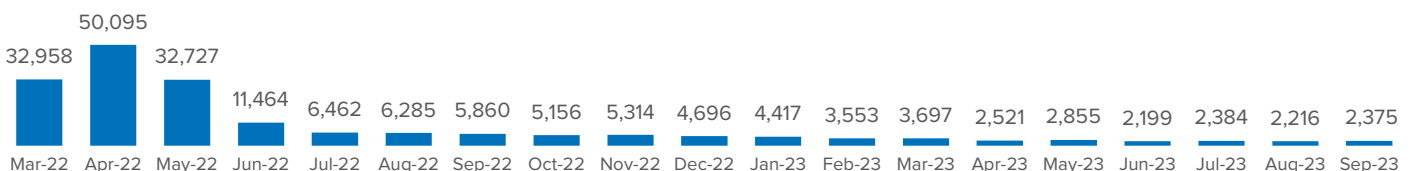
Number of temporary protection applications by gender/age

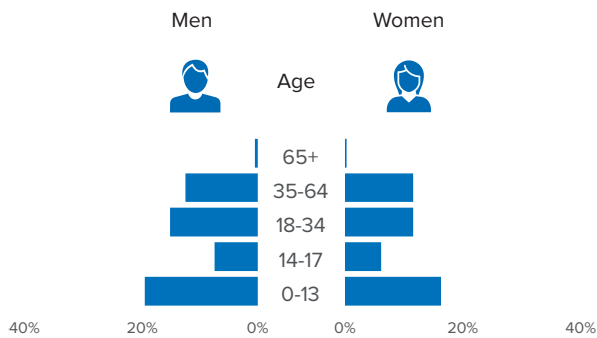

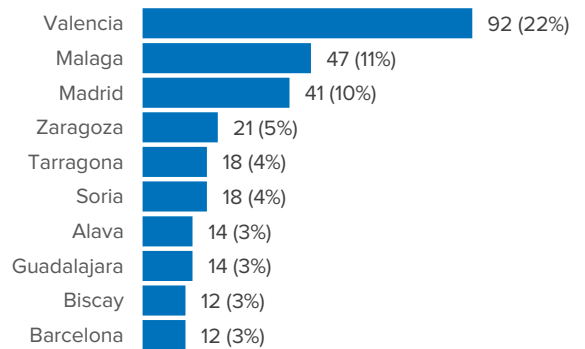

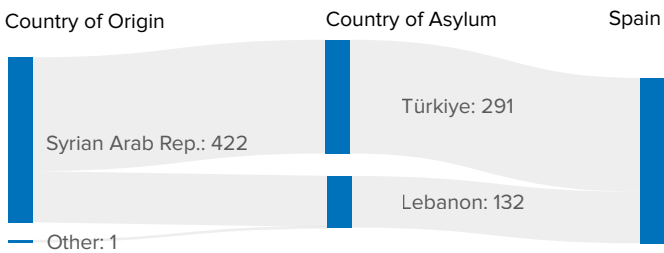
Refugees resettled in Spain by gender/age



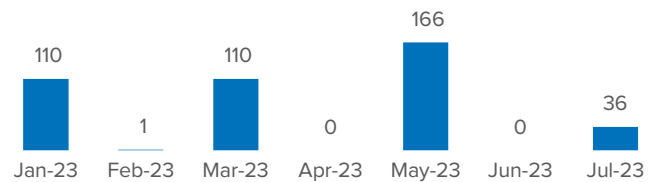
Main provinces of resettlement
