## WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) has slightly increased from 545,500 last week to 546,400 this week.

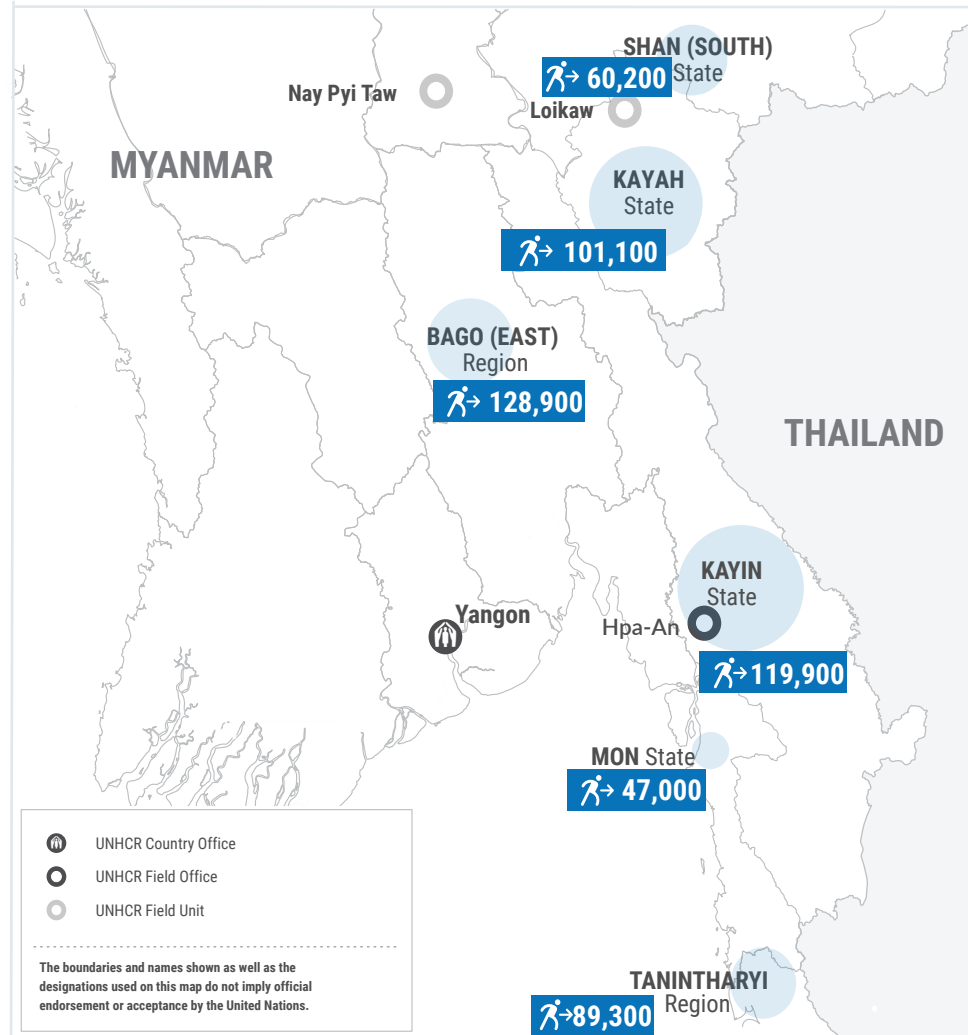
In Kayin State, due to intensified fighting, 870 IDPs from Kyainseikgyi Township were displaced within the same Township.

In Mon State, 7,000 IDPs were verified in Kyaikmaraw Township as a result of increased fighting. Among them, 6,168 IDPs were displaced within Kyaikmaraw Township, while 832 IDPs came from Kyainseikgyi Township, Kayin State.

In Tanintharyi Region, heightened conflict caused the displacement of 850 IDPs in Thayetchaung Township and 1,046 IDPs in Launglon Township. Notably, 5,510 IDPs have returned to their places of origin in Thayetchaung, Yebyu and Launglon Townships.

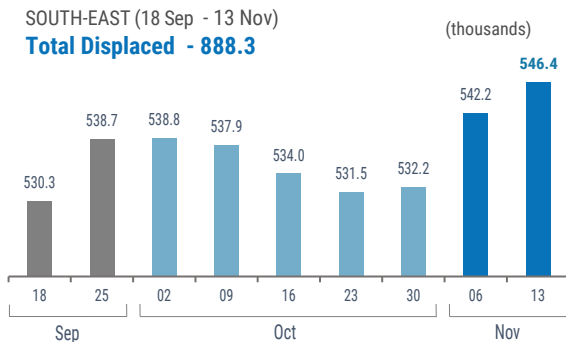
