## **WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS**

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) has increased from 552,200 last week to 583,900 this week.

In Kayah State, due to intensified fighting, 2,418 IDPs from Loikaw Township were displaced to Hpruso Township and within the same Township. In Shan State (South), due to intensified fighting, 14,222 IDPs from Loikaw Township in Kayah State, and 1,460 IDPs from Pekon Township were verified in Hsihseng, Nyaungshwe, Pekon, Pinlaung and Taunggyi Townships.

In Kayin State, 650 IDPs from Kawkareik Township and 127 IDPs from Kyainseikgyi Township were displaced to Hpa-An, Myawaddy, Kawkareik and Kyainseikgyi Townships due to fighting near their village. However, 1,184 IDPs returned to their places of origin in Kyainseikgyi Township. In Mon State, 8,100 IDPs from Kyaikmaraw Township and 2,918 IDPs from Ye Township were displaced to Mawlamyine and within their respective Townships due to intensified fighting.

In Tanintharyi Region, due to intensified fighting, 100 IDPs from Dawei Township, 2,135 IDPs from Tanintharyi Township, 1,124 IDPs from Launglon Township, and 1,635 IDPs from Kyunsu Township were displaced within their Townships. Among them, 759 IDPs were displaced as a secondary displacement. However, 1,260 IDPs returned to their places of origin in Yebyu Township.
