WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) increased significantly from 583,900 last week to 608,000 this week.

In Kayah State, due to intensified fighting including airstrikes, 5,551 IDPs from Loikaw Township were displaced to Demoso and Hpruso Townships, as well as within the same Township.

In Kayin State, due to intensified fighting, 12,302 IDPs from Kawkareik Township, were displaced to Hpa-An Township, 300 IDPs from Kawkareik Township, 2,237 IDPs from Kyainseikgyi Township, and 3,600 IDPs from Myawaddy Township were displaced within their Townships. Furthermore, 89 IDPs from Taungoo Township in Bago (East) Region, were displaced to Thandaunggyi Township. Among the IDPs in Hpa-An Township, originated from Kawkareik Townships, 1,502 people were displaced as a secondary displacement within Kayin State. Verification is still ongoing for displacements from Kawkareik town and Kyone Doe town in Kawkareik Township, as well as for displacements from Kyainseikkyi town, Kyaikdon town, and Payarthone Su town in Kyainsiekkyi Township.

In Shan (South) State, 519 IDPs from Pekon Township and 1,037 IDPs from Loikaw Township in Kayah State were displaced to Hsihseng, Pekon and Taunggyi Townships due to intensified fighting, including indiscriminate shelling.




