

WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) has significantly increased from 668,300 last week to 677,600 this week.

In Bago Region (East), due to intensified fighting, 1,283 IDPs from Taungoo and 1,043 IDPs from Kyaukkyi Townships were displaced within their Townships, and 1,334 IDPs from Yedashe Township were displaced to Taungoo Township. 1,043 IDPs from Kyaukkyi Township were displaced as a secondary displacement within their Township.

In Kayin State, due to ongoing fighting, 405 IDPs from Kawkareik Township were displaced to Hpa-An Township and another 949 IDPs from Kawkareik Township were displaced within the same Township.

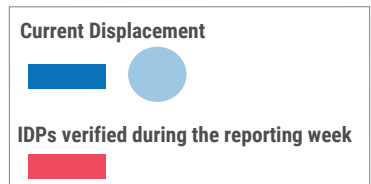
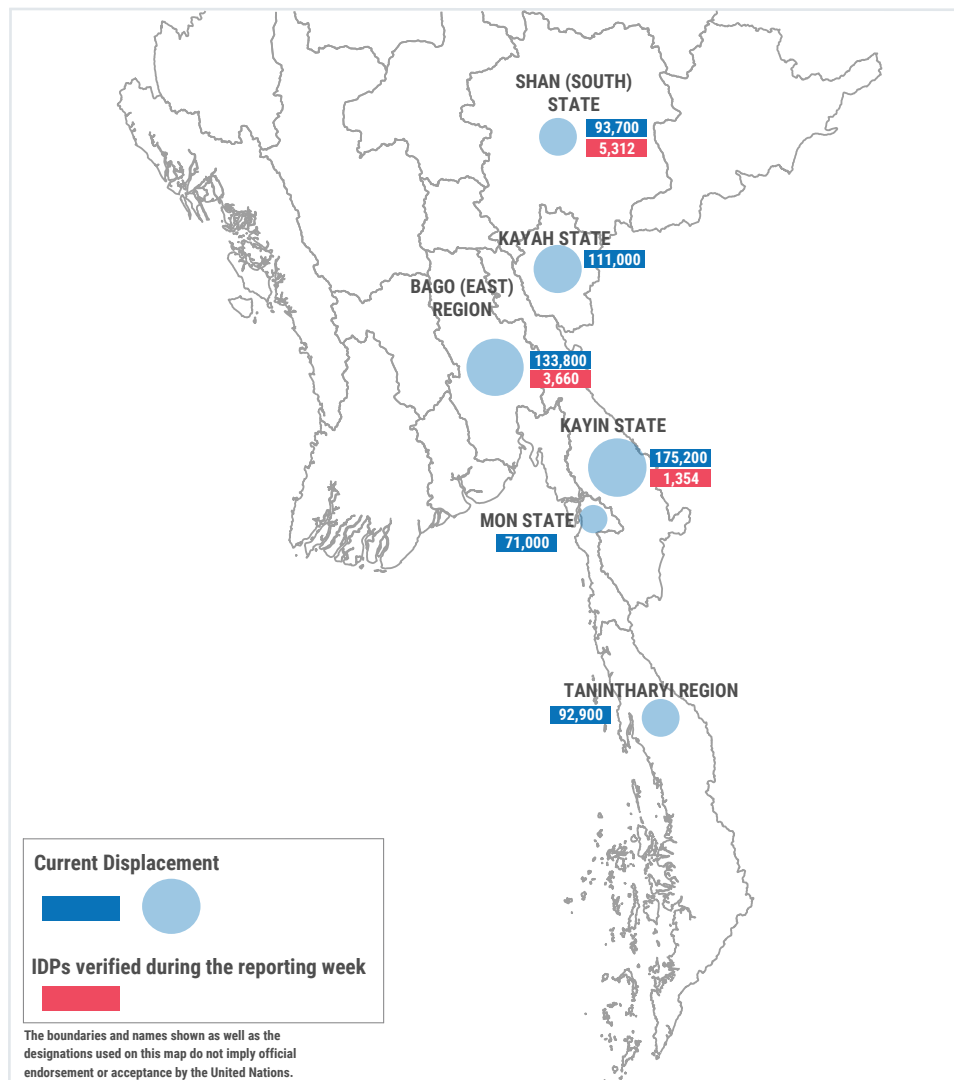
In Shan State (South), a total of 5,312 IDPs from Loikaw Township were displaced to Shan State (South). Among them, 516 IDPs were displaced to Kalaw Township; 4,642 IDPs to Nyaungshwe Township; 70 IDPs to Taunggyi Township; and 84 IDPs to Hopong Township due to intensified fighting, including indiscriminate shelling and airstrikes.

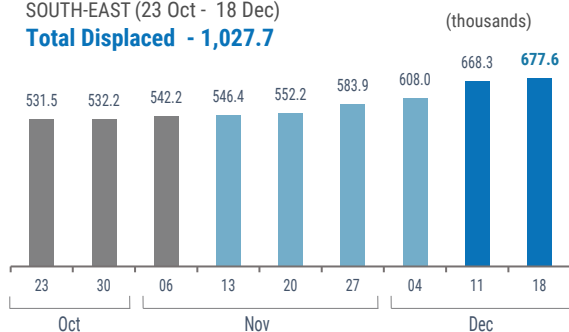
