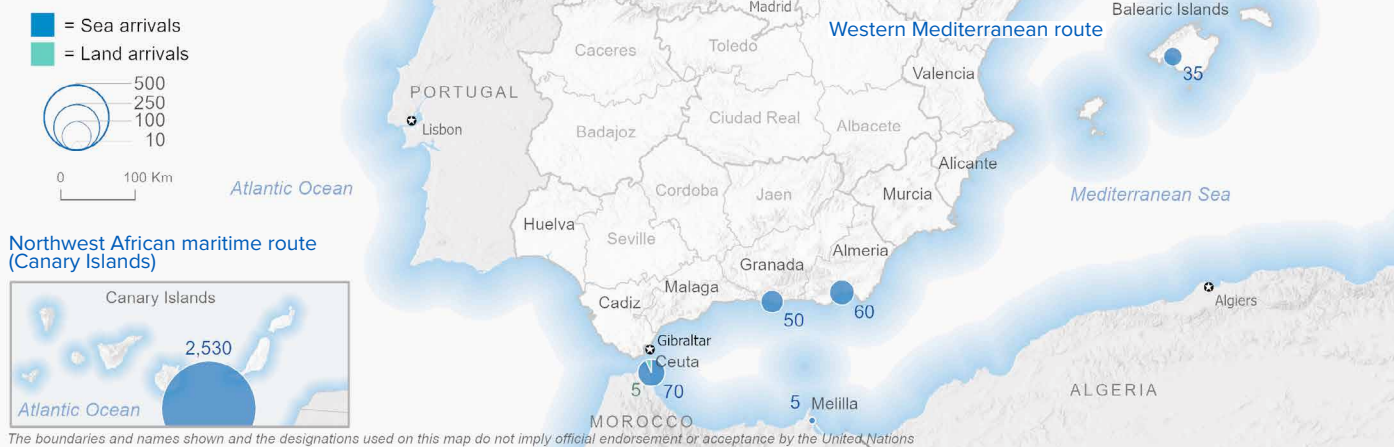


# SPAIN Weekly snapshot - Week 5 (29 Jan - 4 Feb 2024)

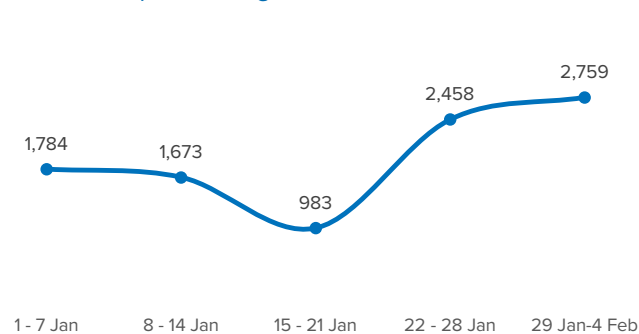

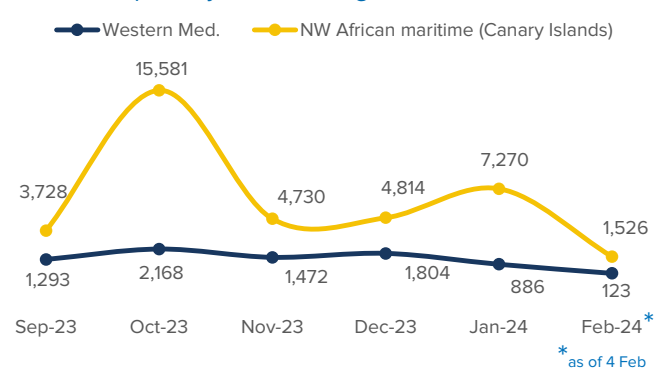

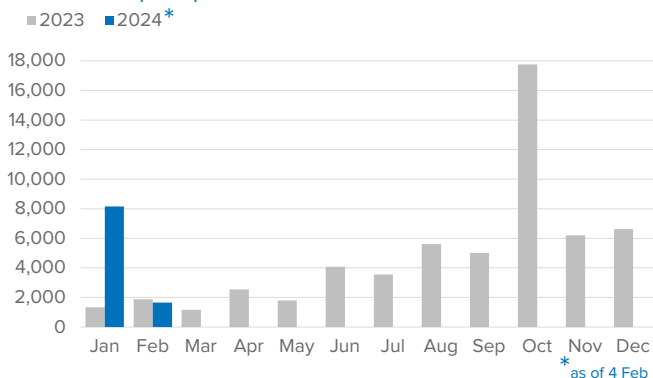
## Arrivals in Spain during the last five weeks<sup>1</sup>
