of the required budget was committed

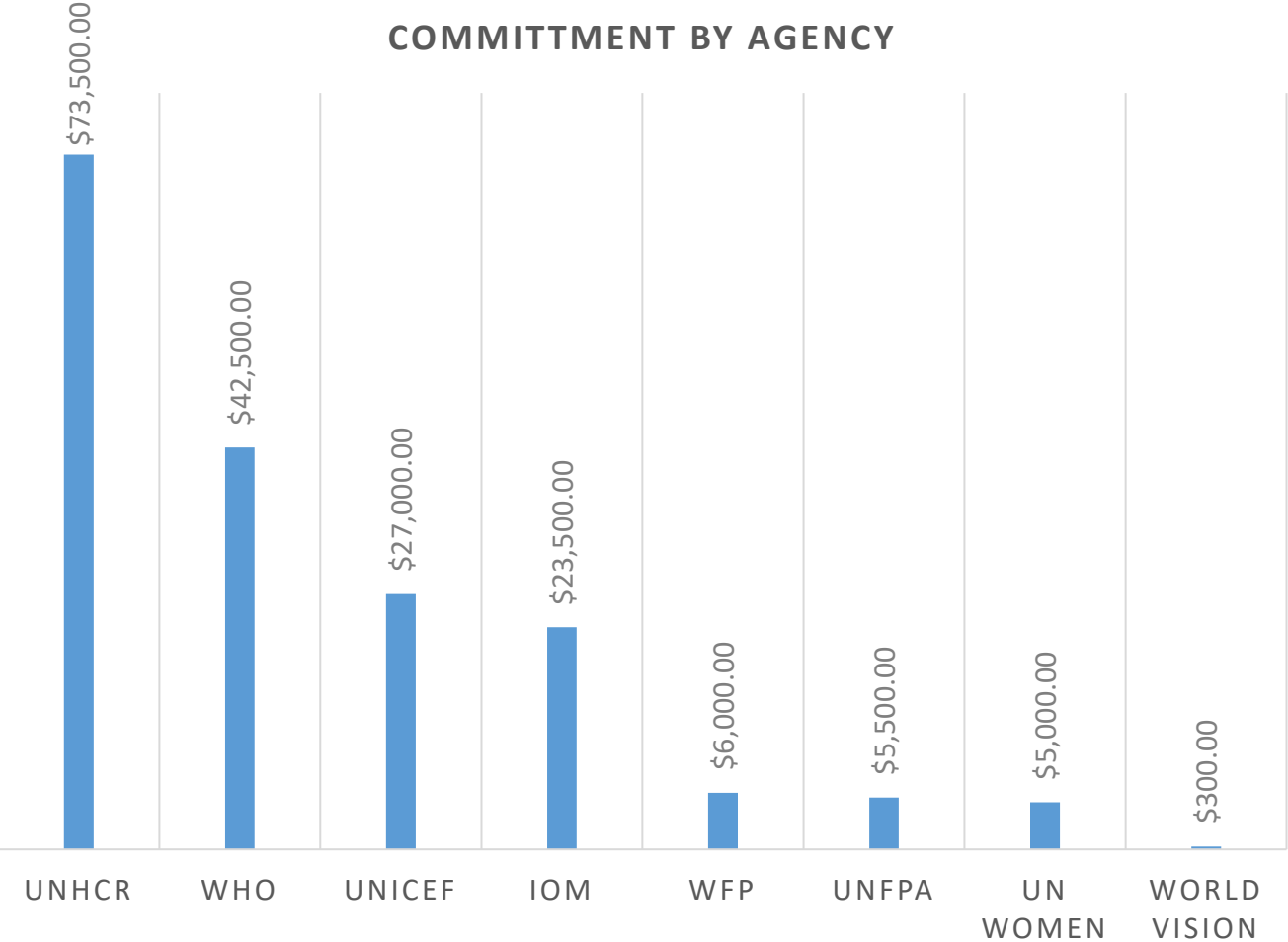
**7 UN agencies**

committed between \$127,000 and \$2,500

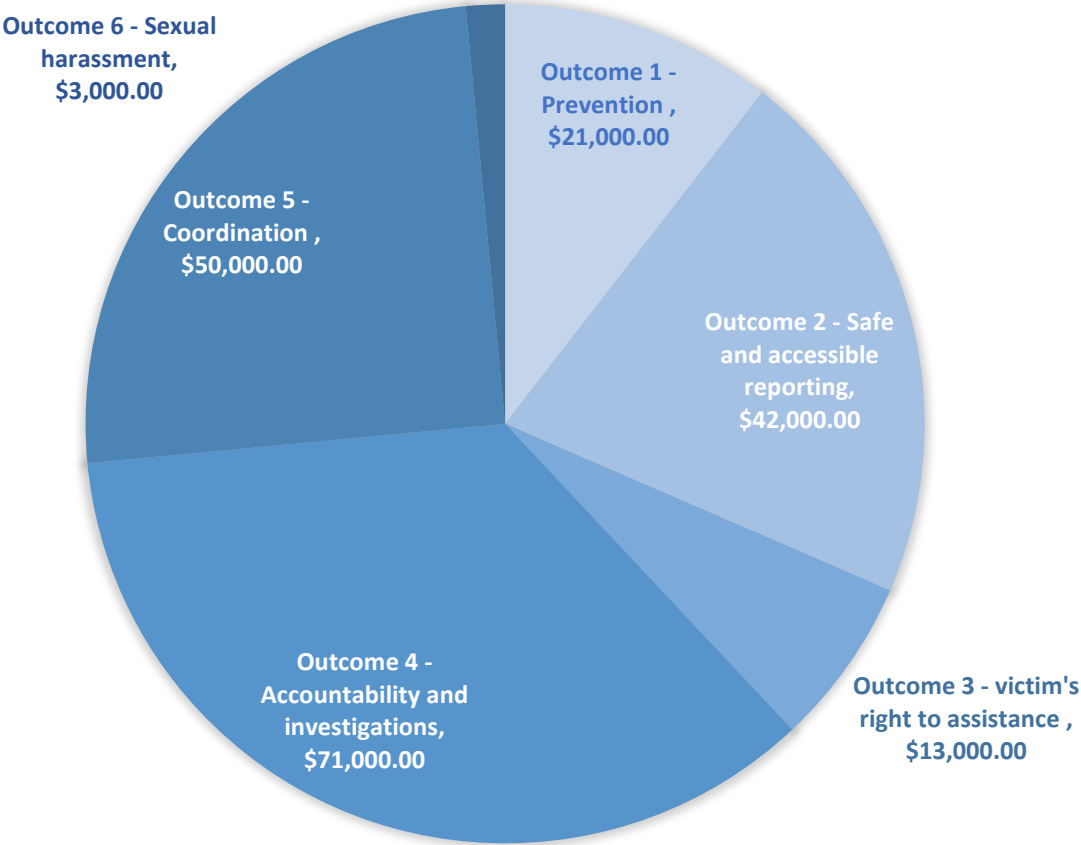


# Financial breakdown
