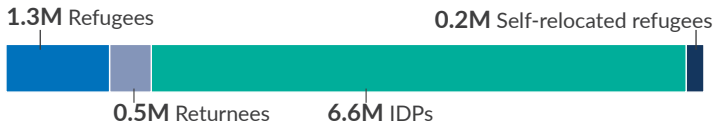
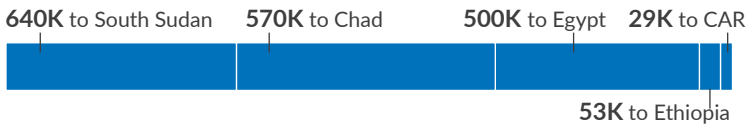

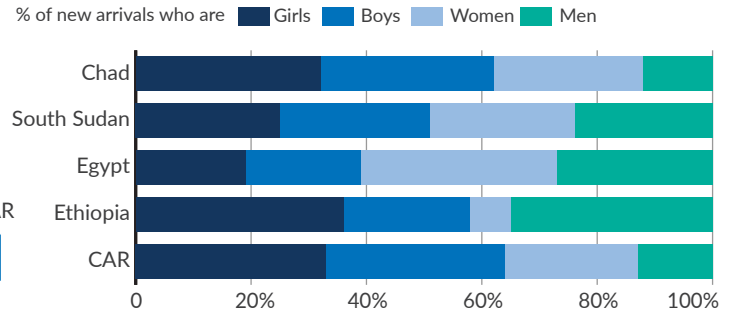
Who are the **8.6M** forcibly displaced?



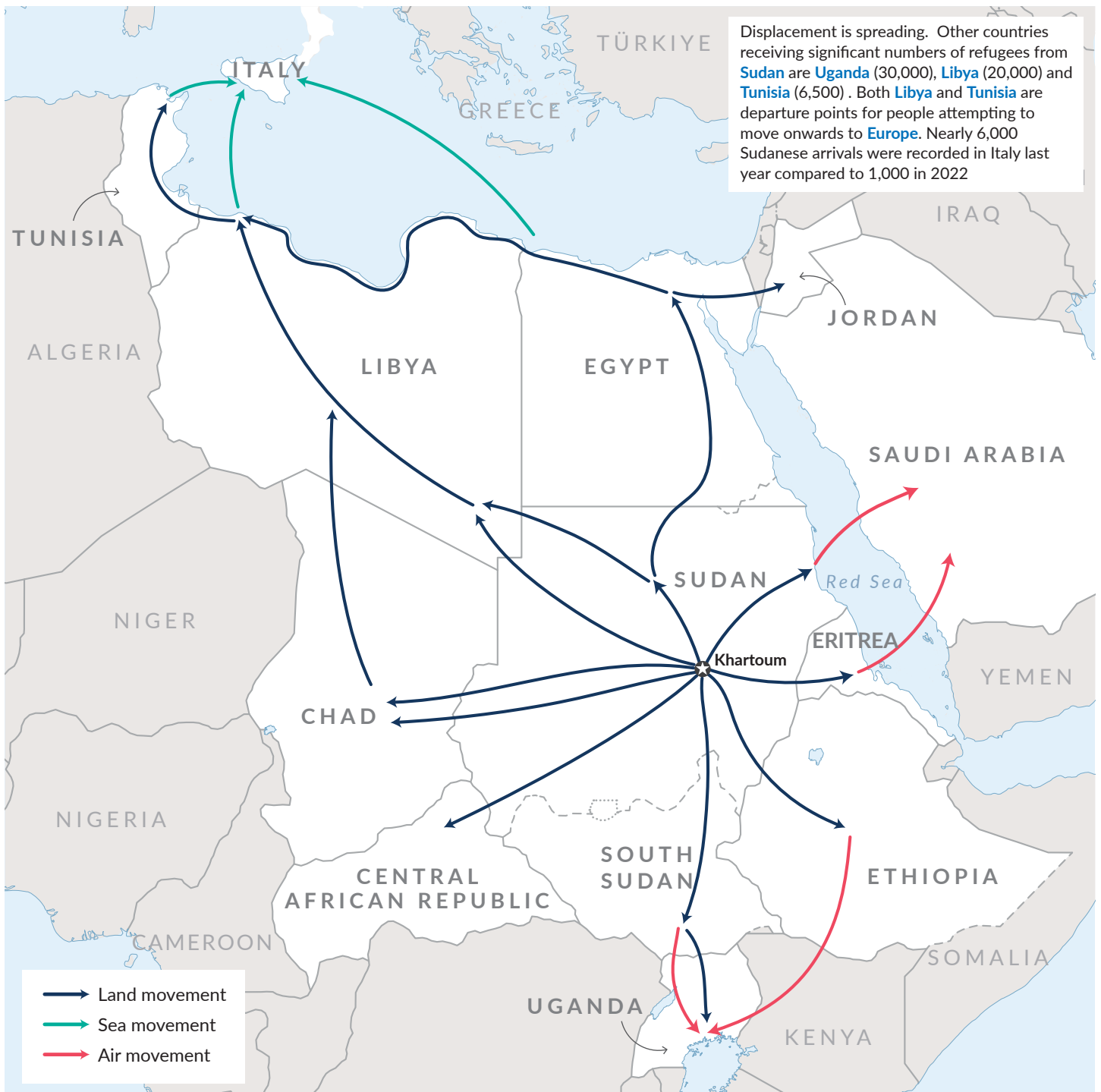
Where did the **1.8M** refugees and returnees go?



Demographic profile of the **1.8M** people who fled Sudan

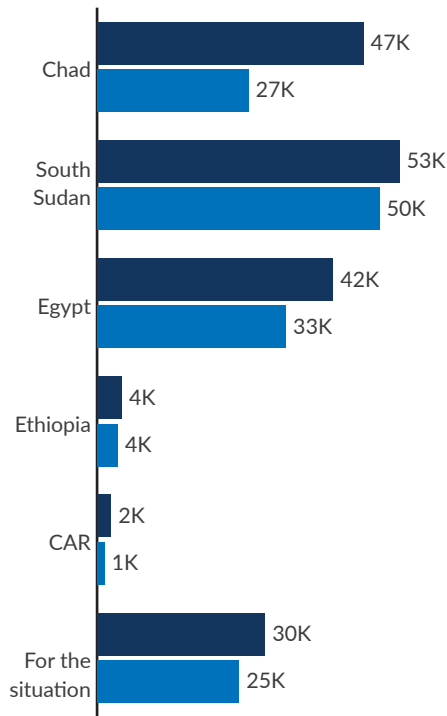

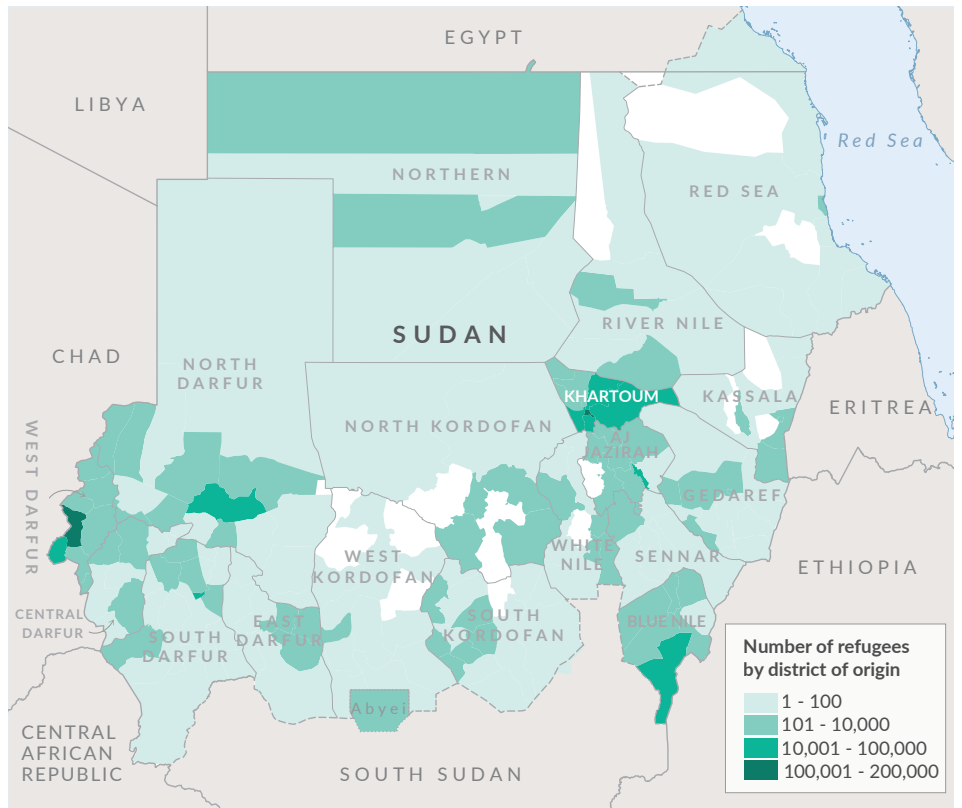

Comparing monthly arrival between 2023 and 2024

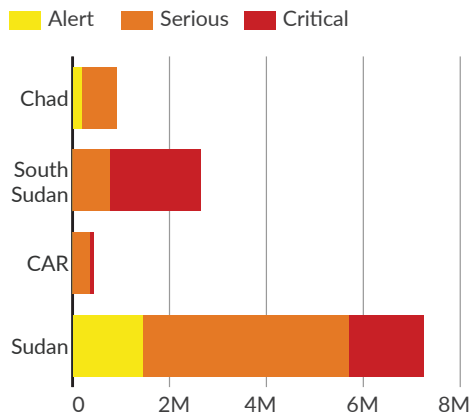


### Refugee population by district of origin

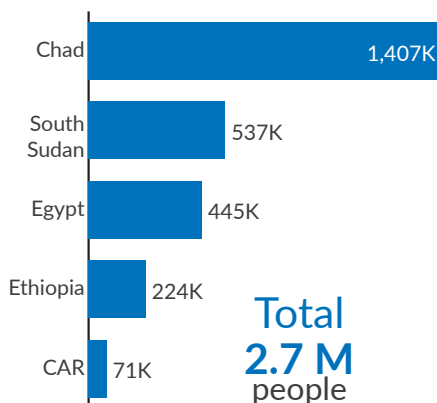
