1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The meeting began with a round of introductions, allowing attendees to introduce themselves and their respective organizations. Present were representatives from various organizations: WFP, Helpage, World Vision International, Hope4. 	
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • WFP – provides three hot meals and a snack through Helpage in RACs, as well as a hot meal and/or a snack through ACF. • Helpage - is providing food assistance to 36 RACs + 1 TAC, with 3 RACs closed recently. Approximately 2,100 individuals are receiving three meals a day. 2 more RACs are planned to be closed by the end of the month. WFP will reach out to UNHCR for further information on RAC closures, particularly regarding the RAC in Greblesti. • ACF - ACF is providing food assistance at Palanca and Otaci borders. In March, were distributed 122 hot meals and 185 snack kits (85 fish, 100 meat) in Otaci, and 179 hot meals and 187 snack kits (91 fish, 96 meat) in Palanca. • Hope4 - Hope4 is distributing canned food boxes from their warehouse to Ukrainian refugees, with 4,213 people registered. No external requests were received in March. Hope4 will contact Eco Razeni organization regarding food provision for day centers, given WFP's information about donor discontinuation. • WVI - WVI has reached 1,210 households out of 1,338 for activity 1, totaling \$271,289.559. They aim to finalize assistance withdrawal and verification by April 10th. Activity 2 involves capacity strengthening for 2,000 governmental employees by the month's end.
