Introduction	Alberto Tonon welcomed participants and apologized for the change in meeting time due to a scheduling conflict.	
Social Listening Report, NCUM	<p>The social listening was presented by the National Congress of Ukrainians of Moldova in partnership with UNICEF.</p> <p>Key findings: High interest in detailed information on social protection, healthcare, education, and child protection sectors. The report is developed via collected comments and conducting assessments in 52 channels in Telegram, Viber, Facebook. The main concern Education for Children, in particular Ukrainian classes, access to medical services.</p> <p>Action Points: Promote TP (Temporary Protection) for children, detailed info dissemination via social media, and monthly live sessions on Telegram.</p>	
Ukrainian Classes and Education Updates, NCUM	<p>Updates on the introduction of Ukrainian language classes in Gymnasia n.a. Taras Shevchenko, Chisinau. Highlighted the importance of integrating Ukrainian children into the Moldovan education system and provide the right information for families to ensure they are encouraged to sign up their children in the school system.</p> <p>Request to disseminate the information regarding possibility to enroll children in Ukrainian classes. At the moment, 48 children registered in 1st grade, 15 places left in 4th grade and 19 places left in 5th grade.</p> <p>Action Points: Open additional Ukrainian classes, focus on providing resources and support for education and work together with the Education WG to support the back-to- school campaign for 2024.</p>	



Female Support Force and NCUM advocacy on Ukrainian Vehicles	<p>Presentation on advocacy efforts for Ukrainian refugees around presence of Ukrainian vehicles in Moldova. Actions taken: conducted meeting with Government representatives, conducting assessment by FSF.</p> <p>NCUM addressed to the Parliament of Moldova with request to change the legislation and received positive feedback: Ukrainian cars will be able to stay in Moldova till the end of the war in Ukraine, although the official law changing will be presented later.</p>	
Participatory Assessment 2024	<p>Brief on the upcoming assessment from UNHCR who will be also in 2024 will be an AAP exercise. UNHCR will share follow up information requesting partners to share their interest and availability to support in the data collection.</p> <p>Action Points: Complete and submit the assessment form by the specified deadline.</p>	
Open Floor for Participants' Updates	<p>We World shared information on their community center providing psychological support. Encouraged dissemination of this information to beneficiaries.</p> <p>Action Points: Share contact details and further materials about psychological services offered.</p>
