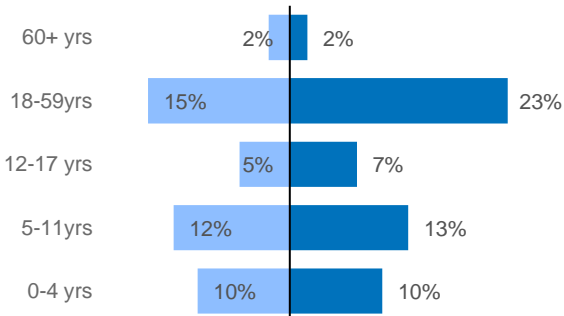

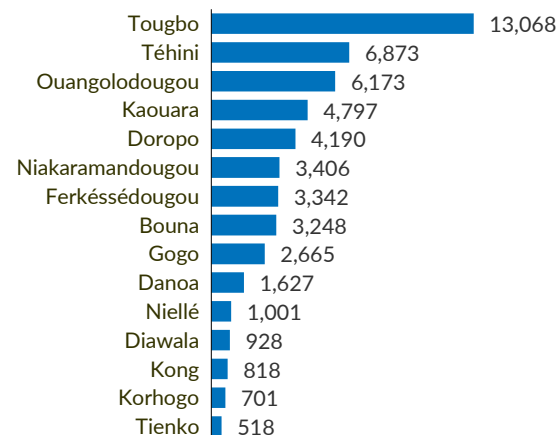

Male (45%)  Female (55%) 



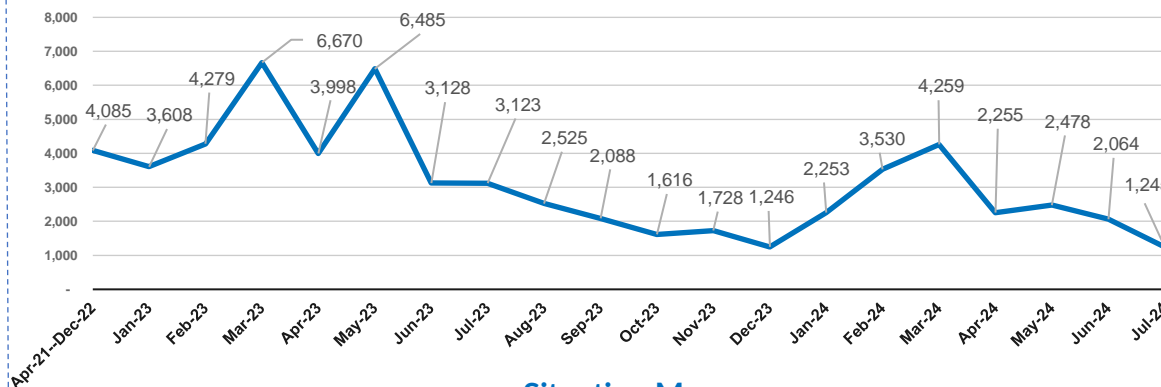
Sub-prefectures hosting asylum seekers*



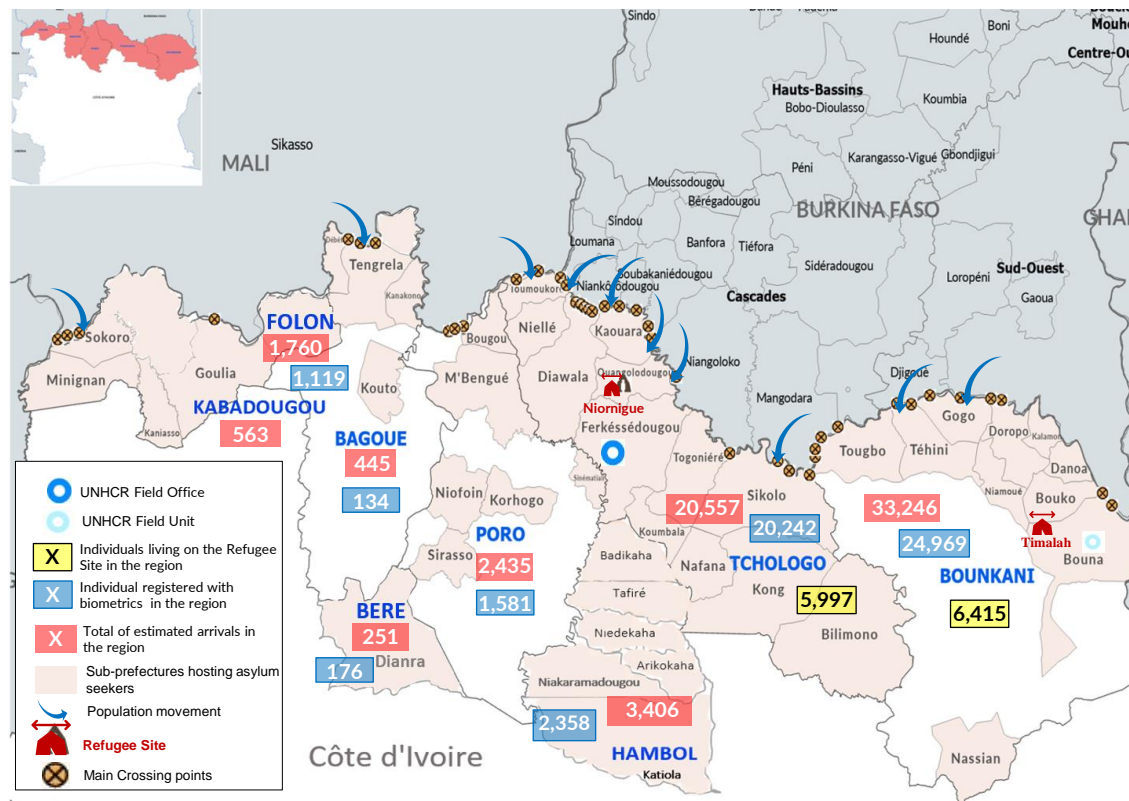

The main reasons for the departure of asylum seekers from their villages in Burkina Faso are **armed conflicts / generalized insecurity, threats, intimidation and attacks by non-state armed groups in the villages.**

Situation Map

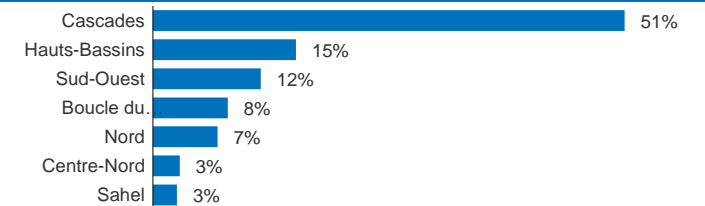

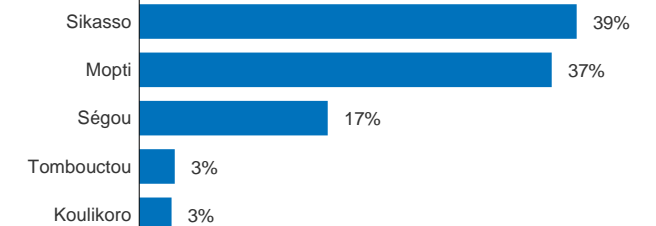
Country of Origin of registered asylum seekers



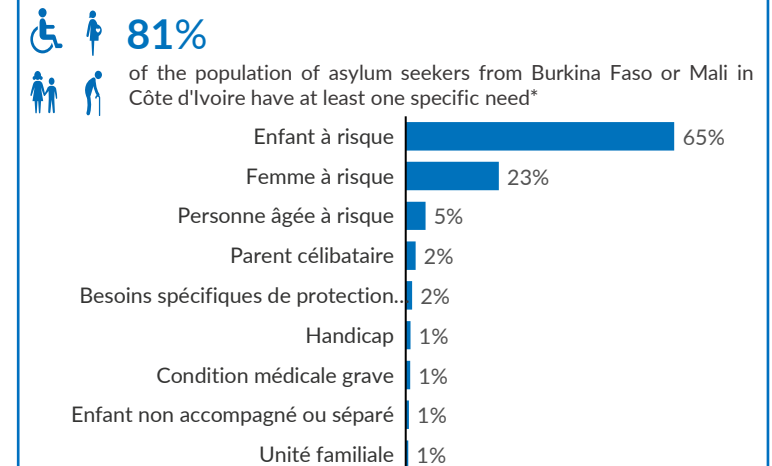
Principal régions of origin in Burkina Faso *
