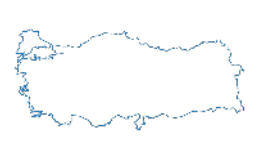

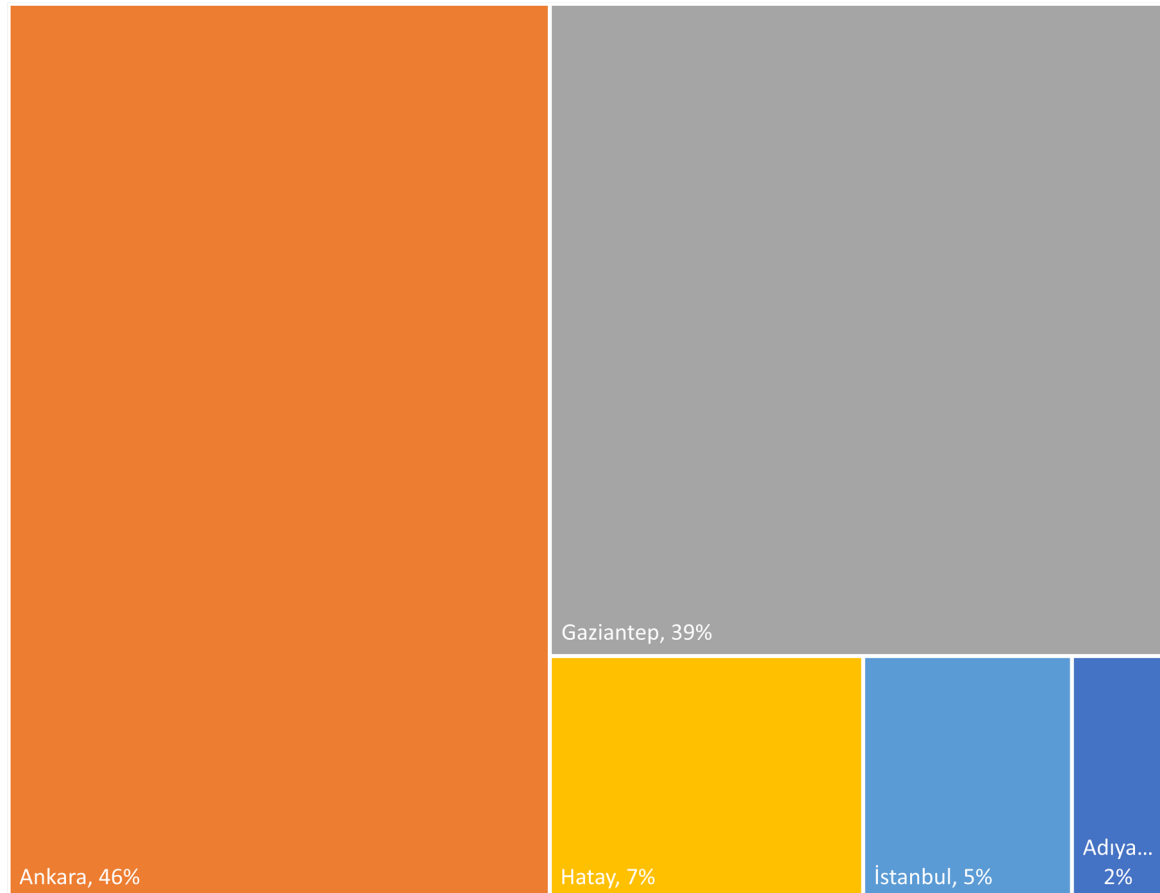

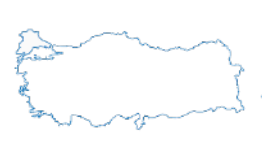

Overview of Market Price Tracker



Objective:

- To provide up-to-date market prices for essential goods and services.

Key Features:

- Automated price data collection every Wednesday afternoon.
- Coverage of essential food and non-food items.
- Public transportation cost calculation for the top 10 provinces with the highest Syrian refugee populations.
- Inclusion of energy costs (electricity, gas, water).
- Upcoming addition of rent prices.

Data Basis:

- Utilizes the Minimum Expenditure Basket (MEB) developed by WFP and TRC for items and amounts.



Data Collection and Calculation



Objective:

- Prices sourced from reliable market websites (e.g., cimri.com).
- Items categorized into food, non-food items, and education materials based on MEB.



Calculation Methodology:

- Weighted average calculation for public transportation costs based on population distribution.
- Comprehensive coverage of essential items to ensure accurate cost representation.





Impact and Future Plans



Impact:

- Facilitates better planning and allocation of resources.
- Helps monitor market fluctuations and trends.
- Supports decision-making for humanitarian aid distribution.



Future Plans:

- Integrate rent prices into the tracker.
- Expand coverage to include different types of baskets.
- Enhance data visualization and reporting features.
