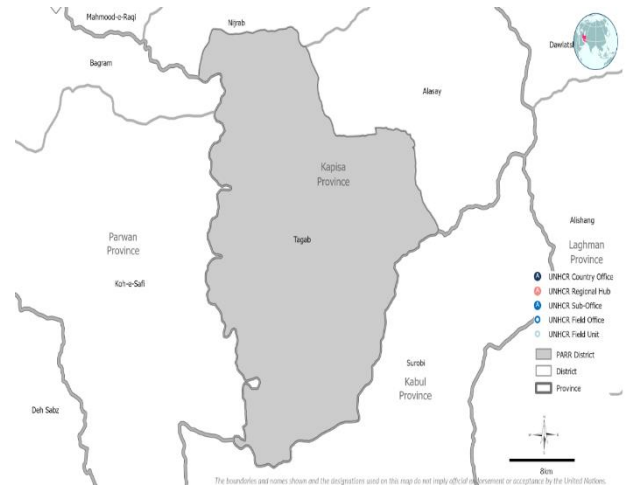

Tagab District is situated in the Eastern part of Kapisa Province borders with Parwan Province to the West, Mahmud Raqi and Njrab district to the North, Alasay district to the East and Kabul province to the South-East. The population is 126,819 individuals estimated. The district centre is the village of "Tamir" located in the Western part of the district. Tagab has 140 villages that are interwoven together in a relatively flat mountainous valley. Tagab district remained as a front line of dispute between the Taliban and the previous government for years. Most of the population of this district displaced to different locations either within the province or they displaced to other secure provinces because of continued conflict in their place of origin. During 2021-2022, hundreds of displaced populations returned to this area and received some return assistance from the humanitarian agencies.
