

# Israeli Hostilities in Lebanon

# SITUATION REPORT #6






### SITUATION OVERVIEW

- During the last two days, about 984 airstrikes and shelling were recorded in various areas of Lebanon, mostly concentrated in the South and the Bekaa.
- The Lebanese Ministry of Health announced that **105** martyrs and **359** wounded were recorded as a result of airstrikes yesterday, bringing the total number since the beginning of the events to **1,745** martyrs and **8,767** wounded.
- To date, **851** centers have been opened to receive displaced persons in public schools, educational complexes, vocational institutes and universities designated by the Ministry of Education and Higher Education and institutes affiliated with the Ministry of Agriculture, and in private schools, and townhalls in various Lebanese regions.
- The number of IDPs from areas subjected to Israeli aggression approached one million, including **153,600** IDPs registered so far in the shelters mentioned in the regulations issued by the National Operations Room, knowing that the largest number of IDPs moved to their homes in other areas or to stay with their families, or in rented houses or hotels, or in public or private places and others, in addition to thousands of others who traveled by air or crossed Lebanese territory to Syria.
- The Directorate General of the Internal Security issued a statement to the families of those missing as a result of the Israeli aggression on Lebanon to facilitate the process of identifying unidentified missing victims or body parts. The Directorate asks the families of the missing to come from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm to one of the offices in the judicial police unit in the governorates, to take the necessary samples to conduct DNA tests, to identify victims or body parts.
- Jordan has provided a donation of humanitarian aid received in the presence of the Jordanian Ambassador to Lebanon and the representative of the Commander of the Army.
- The Lebanese Ministry of Health has received a donation of 11.5 tons of medical supplies from the French Government that will increase the capacity of the sector to deal with emergencies to cope with the repercussions of Israeli attacks.
- To date, the High Relief Commission has distributed 12,187 mattresses and blankets to IDPs in reception centers in Beirut, Mount Lebanon, the North, Bekaa and Akkar.
- The World Food Programme (WFP) has launched an emergency action to provide food assistance to one million people affected by the recent escalation in Lebanon and called on the international community to provide support to provide \$105 million until the end of the year to support the humanitarian response.

### **MOVEMENT OF INTERNAL DISPLACEMENT**


The number of IDPs registered in shelters identified by the National Operations Room has reached **153600** IDPs so far, according to the National Platform.



## **NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS & RESPONSE PLAN**

At the early beginnings of the aggressions, the Lebanese Government through the National DRR Committee to Coordinate Preparedness and Response, in accordance with the National Response Framework, identified the key focus areas of its national preparedness and response plan. This plan aims to mitigate the impact of hostilities in South Lebanon and establish preparedness measure based on potential scenarios.





# **GOVERNMENT RESPONSE PROCEDURES (IN 24 HOURS)**



#### **Civil Defense**

• During the past 24 hours, the Civil Defense carried out 214 missions, including 23 missions to extinguish fires resulting from the Israeli aggression, 33 missions to remove rubble and search for missing persons, 7 missions to transport the wounded, 24 missions to recover and transport the bodies of martyrs, and 72 missions to transport water to shelters for the displaced.



#### **Lebanese Red Cross**

- Distribution of aid to shelters, including the distribution of 14,515 blankets, 681 mattresses, 2,259 food rations, and 1,824 personal hygiene kits.
- The Red Cross sent 278 volunteers to operations rooms in governorates, districts, ministries and the central operations room to provide support and assistance in response operations.
- In the past 24 hours, the Red Cross has provided 36 units of blood to a number of hospitals.



### **Ministry of Public Health**

- The Lebanese Ministry of Health received a donation of 11.5 tons of medical supplies from the French Government to support the health sector to treat emergencies and, in its efforts, to cope with the repercussions of Israeli attacks.
- Providing free services to IDPs in cooperation with parties and partners where patient differences are covered.
- The ministry has increased the number of mobile teams from 25 to 50 and is working to increase them to 80.



#### **Ministry of Education and Higher Education**

- The Ministry of Education coordinates with UN and NGOs to add some means in school buildings to secure the necessary for the displaced.
- The directors of official educational institutions work around the clock in coordination with the crisis cell in the Ministry of Education and the Emergency Committee in the Government Serail to secure the necessary in schools, secondary schools and institutes in coordination with the rest of the ministries and institutions concerned.



### **Ministry of Social Affairs**

- Distributing urgent hygiene tools and materials to adults, women and children in shelters.
- Distribution of humanitarian aid in the districts of Sidon and Jezzine, through the Isosep project funded by the European Union through the Italian Cooperation Office AICS.



### **Ministry of Interior and Municipalities**

- Directing displaced citizens to shelters in various governorates.
- Follow up with governors and sub-security councils in the governorates on policing and suppressing violations, especially in the vicinity of shelters, and deterring attempts to break into and preserve private property.
- Issuing a statement to the families of those missing as a result of the Israeli aggression on Lebanon in order to facilitate the process of identifying unidentified missing victims or body parts. The Directorate asks the families of the missing to come from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm to one of the accident offices in the judicial police unit in the governorates, in order to take the necessary samples to conduct DNA tests, to identify victims or body parts.

## INTERNATIONAL COORDINATION AND SUPPORT

Since the beginning of the aggression, the Lebanese government has taken the initiative to activate the coordination framework between official departments and United Nations organizations operating in Lebanon and their partners within the National Emergency Plan to develop humanitarian response measures for displaced persons and populations residing in the affected areas.
