

# Lebanon Protection Sector: At a Glance

## September 2024

The Protection Sector Q3 Dashboard presents a snapshot of achievements from January to September 2024 and does not reflect the recent escalation of conflict in late September. The Protection Sector in Lebanon aims to strengthen access to fundamental rights for affected individuals by contributing to an effective justice and protection system, fostering community resilience and empowerment, ensuring sectoral accountability, and providing life-saving responses and specialized services for those at heightened risk.

### Key Achievements: January - September 2024

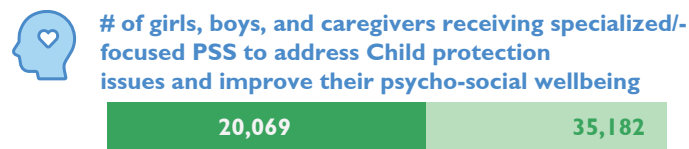
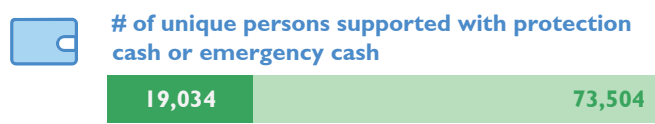
**Outcome 1: Individuals have their fundamental rights respected and have access to an effective justice and protection system.**
