

CAMP BACKGROUND INFORMATION


Part of the East Mosul Camps (EMCs), Hassansham U2 was inaugurated on 9 May 2017, in response to the escalating military offensive conducted to reclaim Mosul. Mostly from the western districts of Mosul City, Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) in Hasansham U2 are primarily Female Headed Households, whose husbands are incarcerated, missing or deceased. They face numerous challenges, including lack of core civil documentation, dire living conditions, and due to their perceived affiliation with Da'esh severe restrictions on their freedom of movement, high risks of harassment and abuse and safety concerns. Their status also impedes on their access to Government support to camp departures, through the request of Tabri'a. Access to basic services, including education, health, and WASH are inadequate, posing significant protection risks and public health challenges. In Hasansham U2, UNHCR provides IDPS with civil documentation support through partner INTERSOS.










POPULATION DEPARTURE TREND - Number of families

since january 2024, 512 families (2066 individuals) departed the camp, mainly through the International Organization of Migration (IOM) and Ministry of Migration and Displacement (MoMD) programmes on organized returns. This figure represents approximately 81% of the population registered as living in the camp as of January 2024. IDPs primarily departed to Ninewa, Duhok, Salah Al-Din, Erbil, Al-Anbar.
