OPERATIONAL DEVELOPMENTS

The Minister of Social Affairs and Solidarity visited Markazi refugee village. On 27 January, the Minister of Social Solidarity HE Ms. Ouloufa Ismail Abdo conducted the final stage of the national solidarity week in the Obock region. The minister visited Markazi refugee site home to more than 2,500 refugees and asylum seekers and held discussions with

Yemeni and Eritrean refugees hosted at the site since 2015. The national solidarity week was launched on 6 January to reaffirm the government commitment to building a more united, inclusive, and resilient Djibouti.

REFUGEE RESPONSE

The ANPH presented the results of the study on needs and barriers affecting refugees living with disability. On 21 January, the National Agency for People living with Disability (ANPH) in collaboration with UNHCR organized a workshop to present the results of the study and analysis on the needs and barriers affecting refugees living with disability in their daily lives. The workshop that brought together different ministries, partners and refugees identified priorities and made recommendations in terms of health, access to clean water, socioeconomic factors influencing disability conditions with a specific focus on work and employment and access to appropriate equipment. Participants raised the needs to accelerate the promotion of effective inclusion with view to helping people living with disability find employment.

UNHCR set to categorize refugees for targeted assistance. UNHCR in Djibouti is set to conduct a socio-economic study for refugees with view to categorizing them for targeted assistance while enhancing self-reliance. For this study UNHCR will collaborate with a local Institution specialized in social studies
