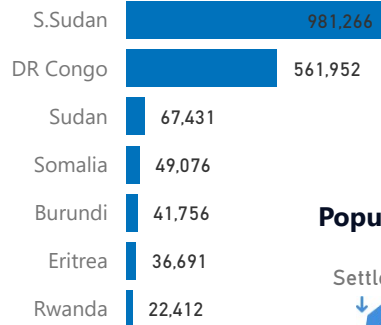

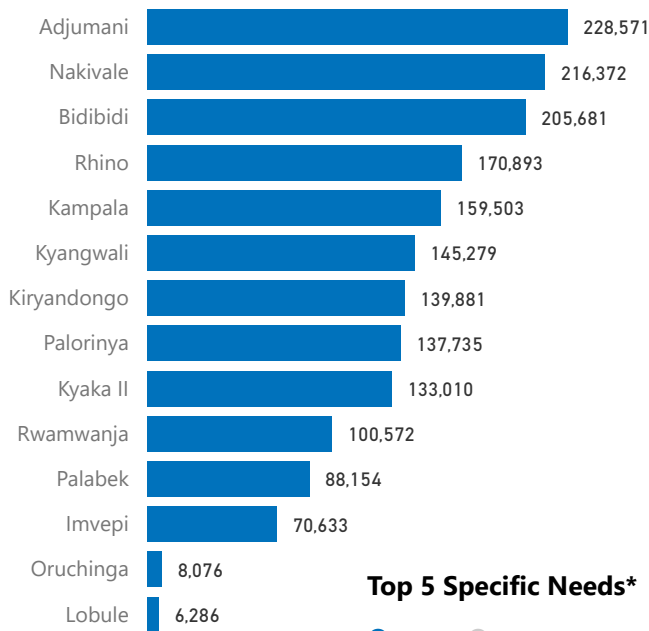

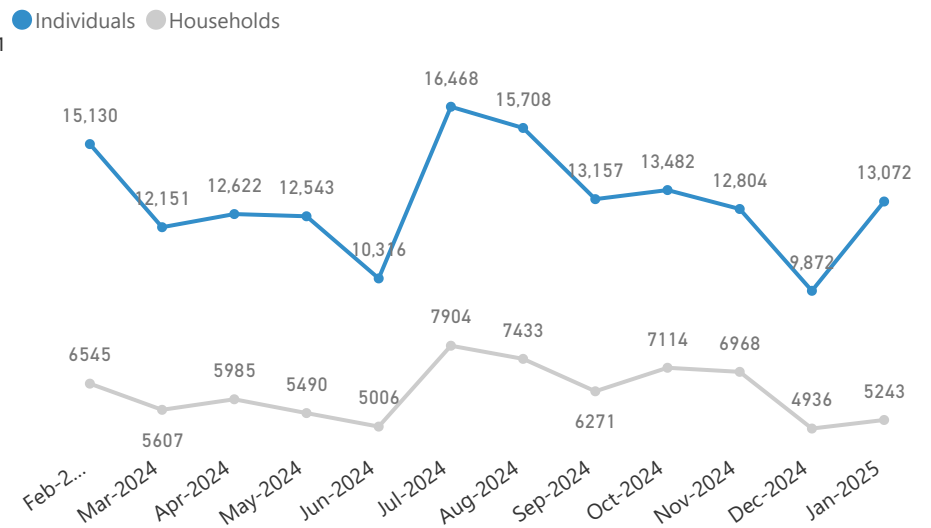
### Population Distribution



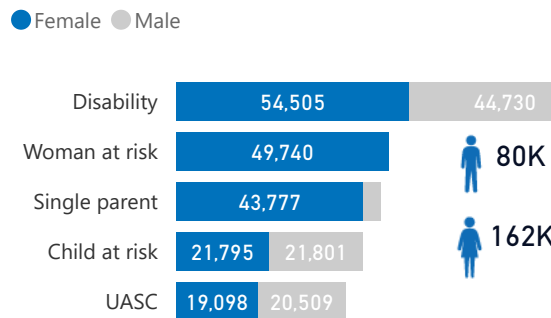
### Population by settlement



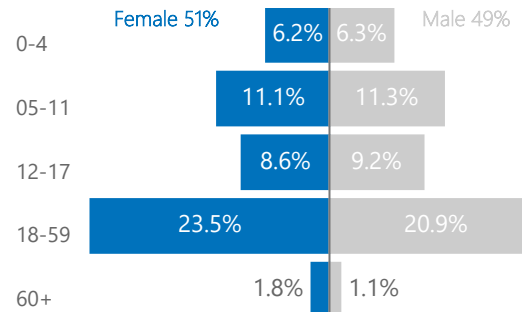

### Age & Gender Breakdown



Since the start of 2025, 14,788 individuals (including 1,716 new births) have been registered in Uganda, 39% of whom are new arrivals from South Sudan, 30% from the DR Congo, 14% from Sudan, and 3% from Eritrea. There was an increase of 14,037 individuals (0.8%) in the population from last month, resulting from new arrival and continuous registration activities. The average number of registered Sudanese since the start of the Sudan conflict in April 2023 is 2,500 individuals per month over the last three months.

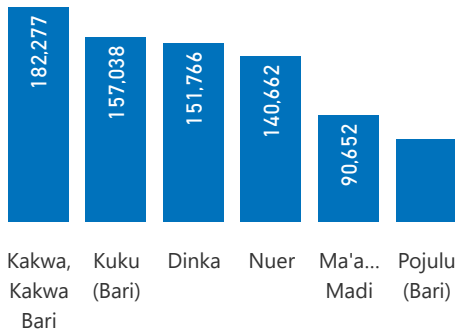

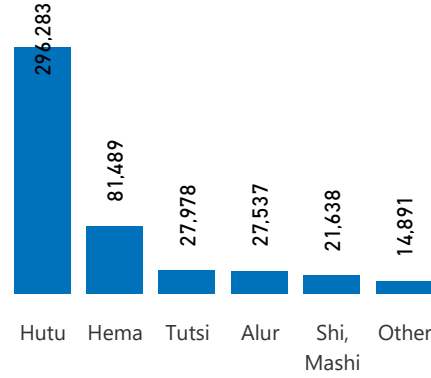

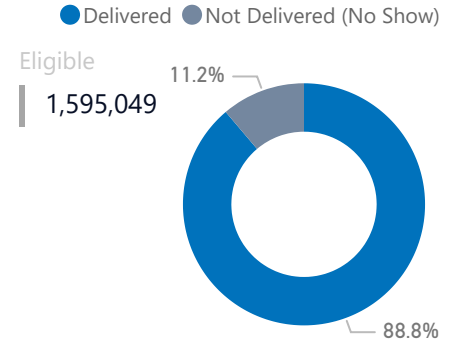
### Top South Sudanese Ethnicities



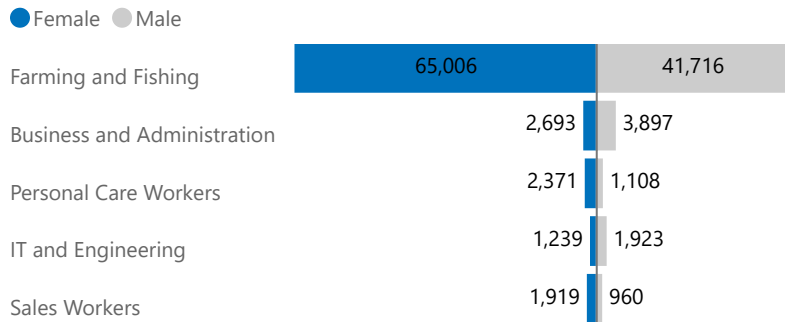

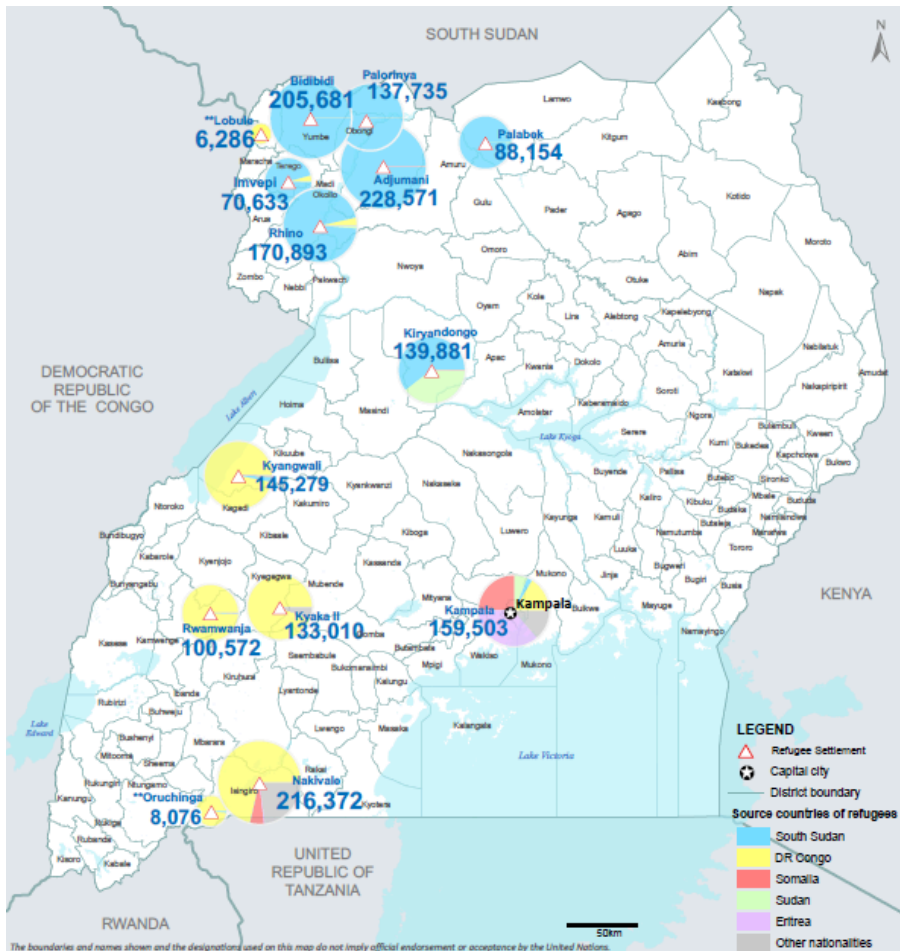
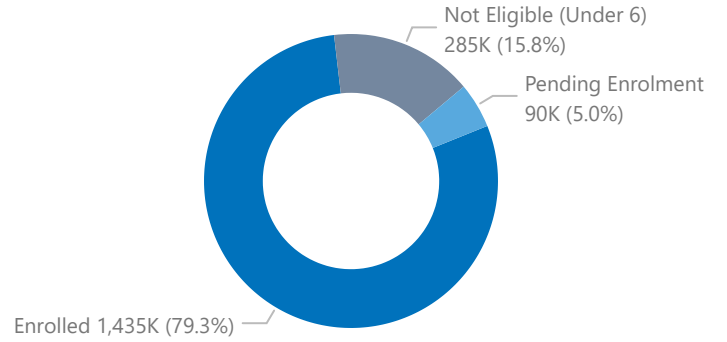
