**Total Rohingya Population**

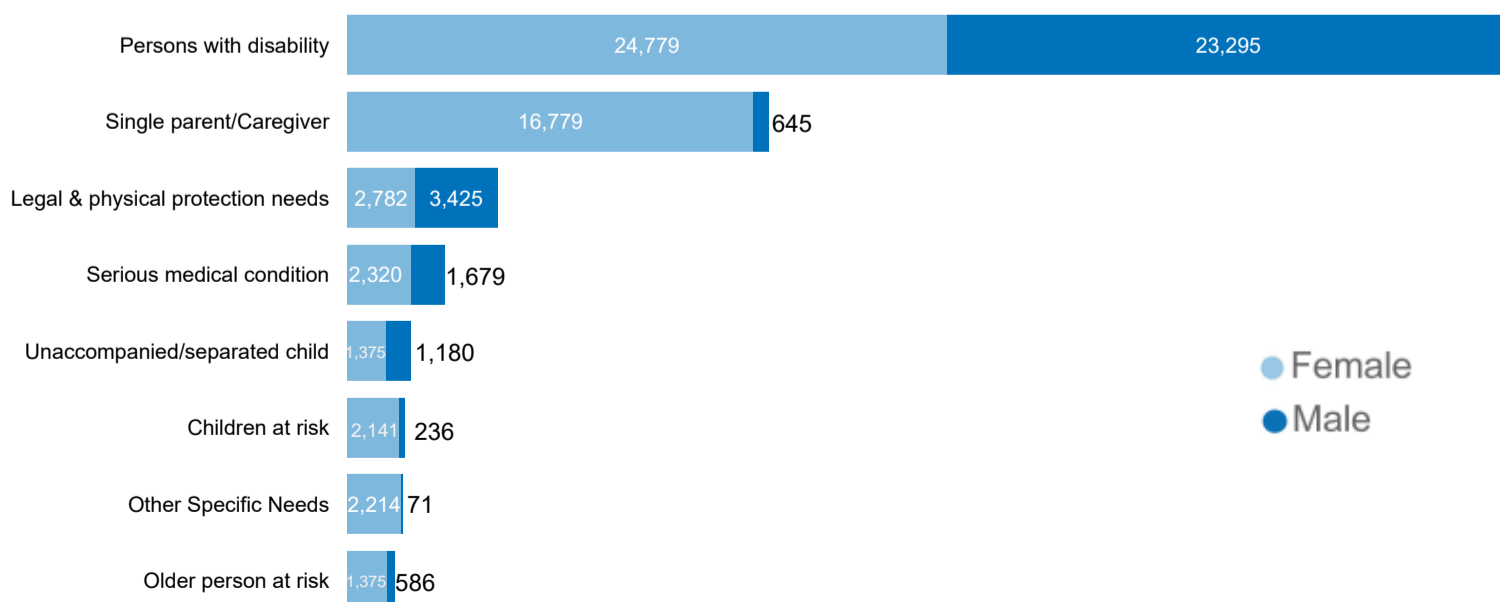

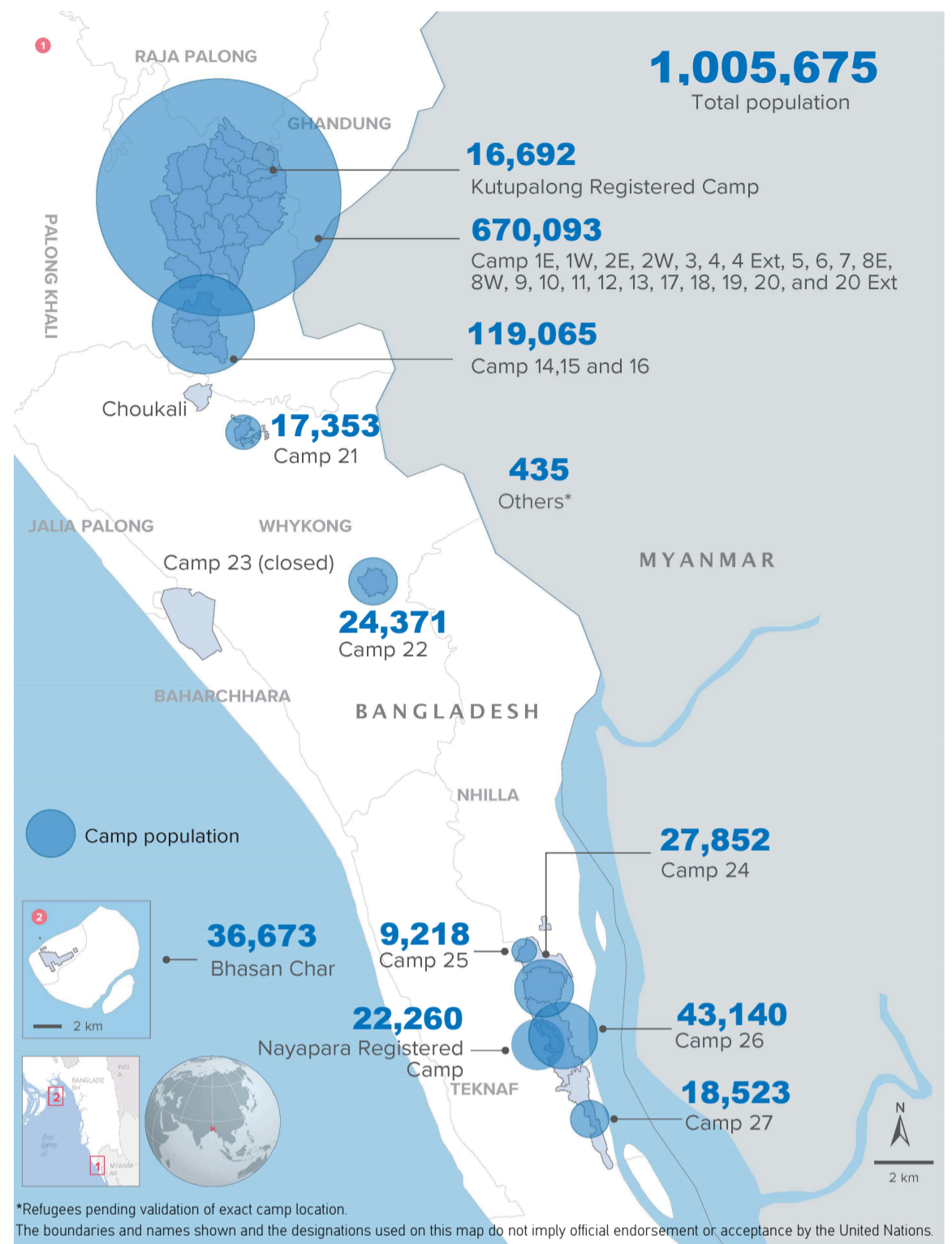


**Specific needs<sup>2</sup>**

**7.84%** of total individuals have been identified with at least one specific need, **4.78%** being Persons with Disability

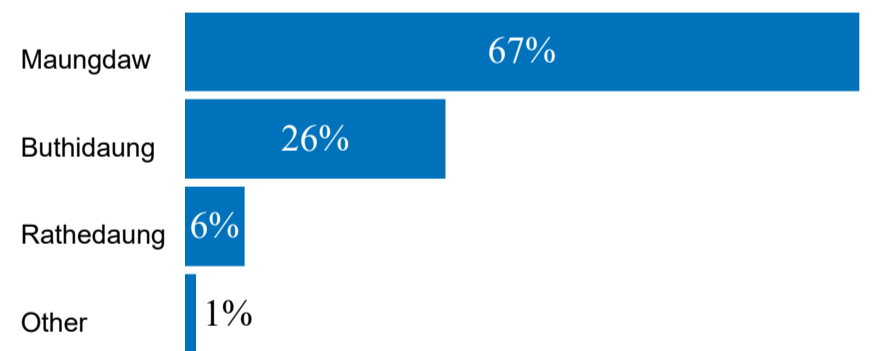


**Rohingya Population by Location**



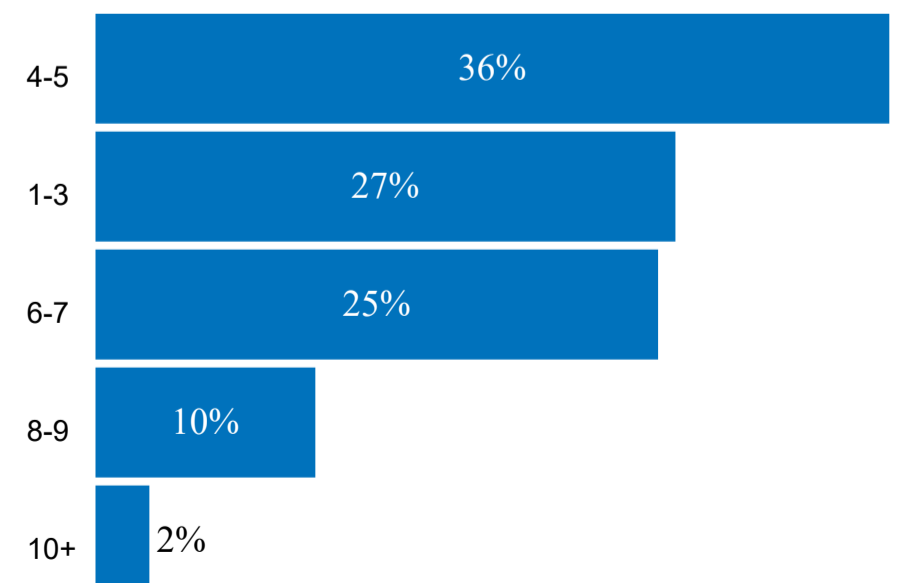
**Place of origin**

This refers to all refugees registered by the GoB from September 2017, including those who arrived during and after the 2017 influx and the previously unregistered Rohingya who arrived in Bangladesh before 2017. The Government refers to this Rohingya population as Forcibly Displaced Myanmar Nationals, FDMN. Population figures do not include unregistered new arrivals. As of October 2024, the RRRCC and UNHCR had counted about 65,000 individuals.
