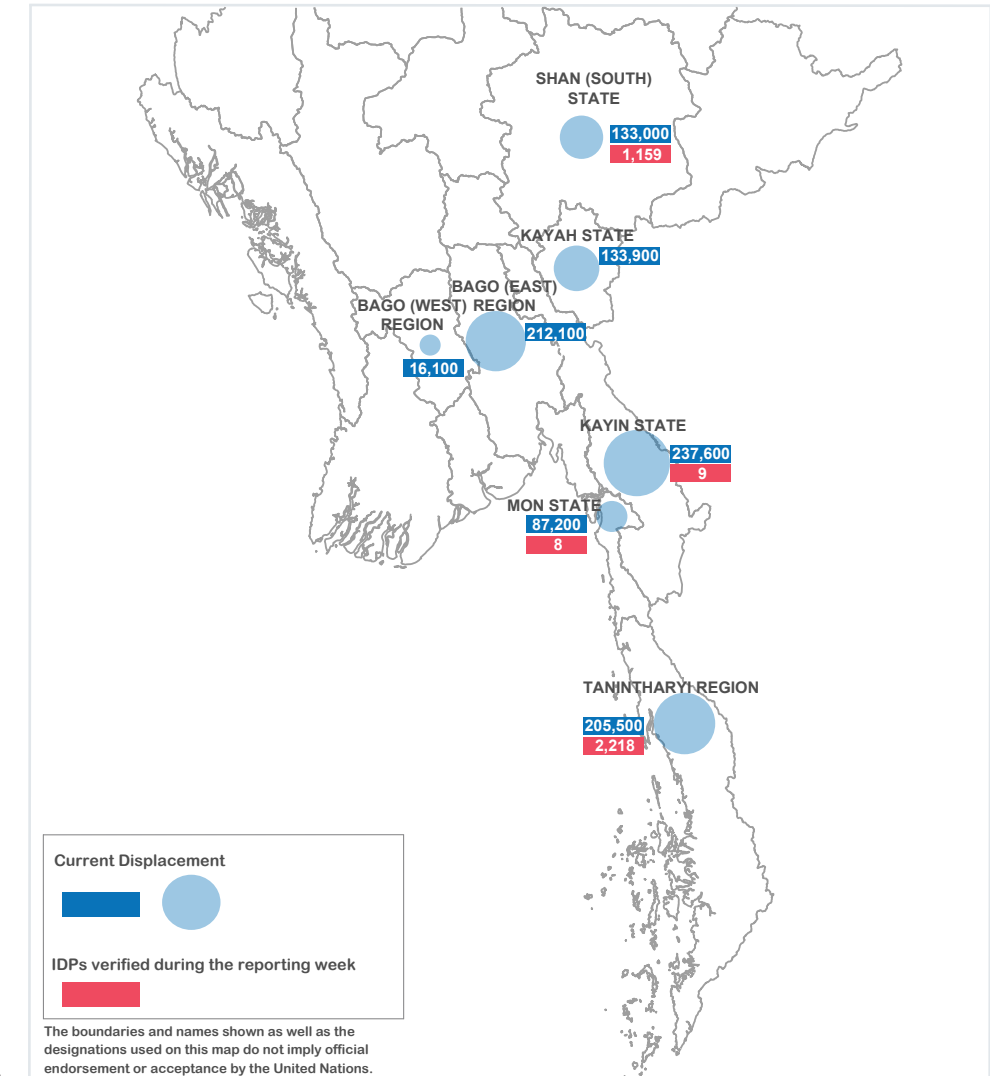

WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

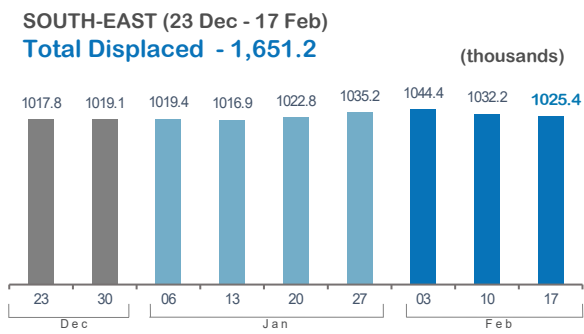
In the South-East, the number of internally displaced people (IDPs) decreased from 1,032,200 last week to 1,025,400 this week.

In Tanintharyi Region, 905 people from Htone Ma Khar village in Tanintharyi Township and 1,313 people from Oke Tu in Thayetchaung Township were displaced within the same townships due to arsons and arrests attributed to the Tatmadaw in the area. In parallel, 3,455 IDPs returned from Nyaung Pin Kwin village in Tanintharyi Township to their places of origin, after being displaced in September 2024.

In Shan State (South), the shelling in Nyaungshwe Township has displaced 554 people. Lawksawk town has become refuge to 365 people fleeing Lashio, Kyaukme, and Hsipaw Townships.

In Mon State, eight people from Nat Gyi village, Bilin Township, were displaced within the same township due to armed conflict. However, 6,551 IDPs returned to their place of origin in Dhamma Tha village, Kyaikmaraw Township, in October 2024, after being displaced in different waves from April to July 2024.
