

WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of IDPs increased from 1,039,500 last week to 1,043,600 this week.

In Tanintharyi Region, 1,010 people from Thein Khun, Tanintharyi Township, were displaced within the same township due to a Myanmar Armed Forces (MAF) troop raid into the villages, resulting in the destruction of the village.

In Kayah State, 871 people from Thit Maw Ku, Hlaingbwe Township, were displaced within the same township due to airstrikes, indiscriminate shelling by the MAF, and potential clashes in the area. Additionally, 930 people from Kamarmaung Town, Hpapun, were displaced to Kawt Yin Lower area, Hpapun, due to potential clashes, indiscriminate shelling, and airstrikes. Furthermore, 12 people from Ta Tan Ku, Kawkareik Township, were displaced to Thar Yar Kone, Hpapun Township, due to intensified fighting.

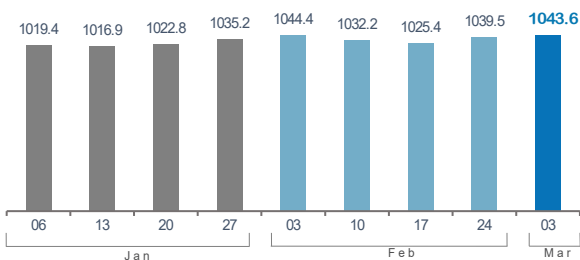
In Mon State, 1,000 people from Ka Taung Ti, Hpapun Township, were displaced to Bilin Town due to airstrikes and indiscriminate shelling by the MAF. Additionally, 305 people from War Boe Chaung, Kyaikto, were displaced to Kaw Kat, Bilin Township, due to airstrikes.

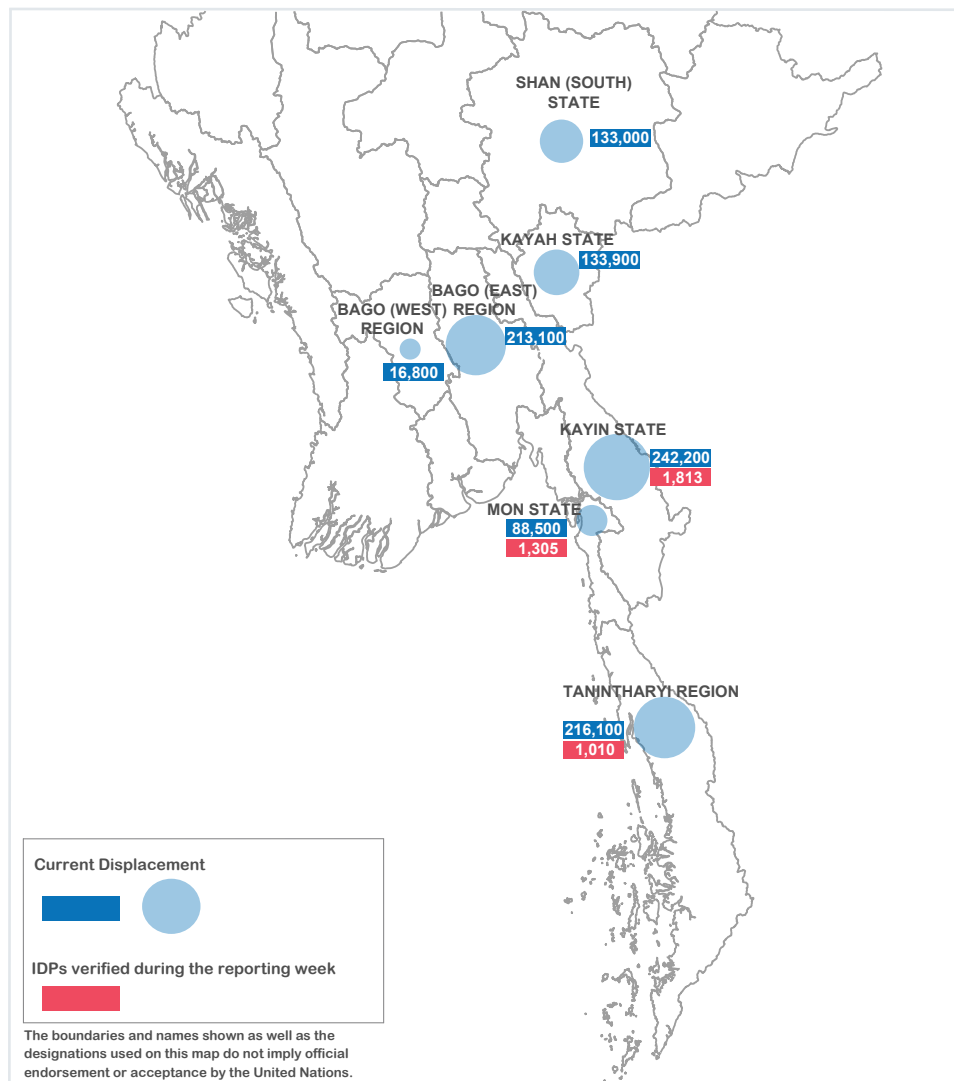
