

WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

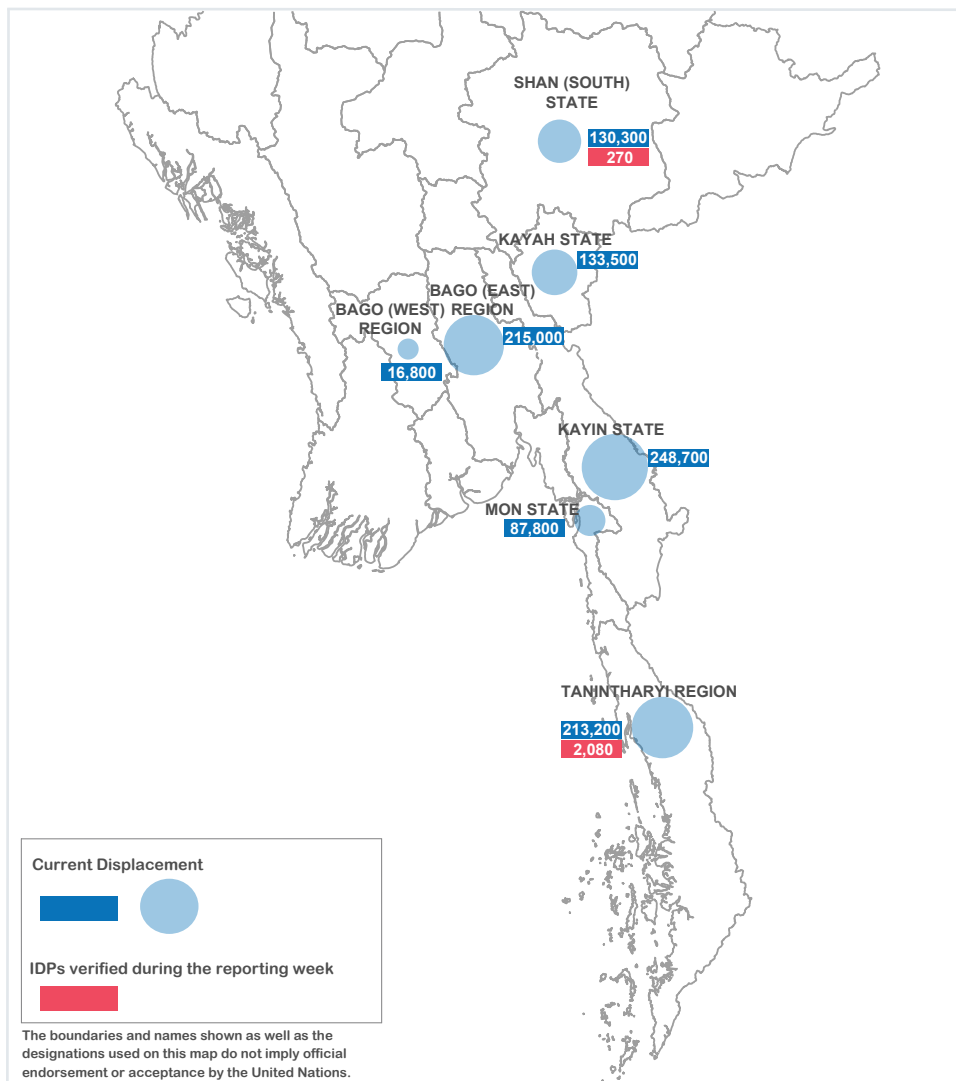
In the South-East, the number of IDPs decreased from 1,050,900 last week to 1,045,300 this week.

In Shan State (South), 270 people from Nyaungshwe Township were displaced within the same township due to shelling and the presence of the coalition of the Tatmadaw and the Pa-O National Army. Additionally, 671 IDPs reportedly returned from Nyaungshwe Township to Loikaw Town, in Kayah State.

In Tanintharyi Region, 530 people from Dawei Township were displaced within the same township, and 1,550 people from Yebyu Township were also displaced within the same township due to the reinforcement of the Tatmadaw's troops. On a contrary movement, 4,783 IDPs reportedly returned to their place of origin in Dawei Township.

In Kayin State, 1,632 IDPs reportedly returned from Taungoo Town to Tha Pyay Nyunt, Thandaunggyi Township.

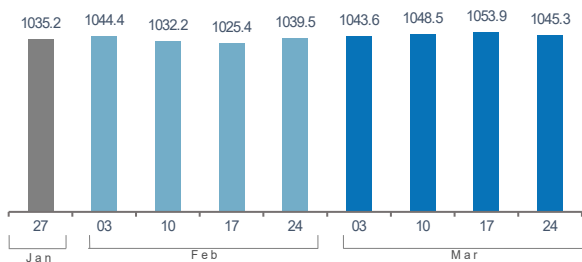
