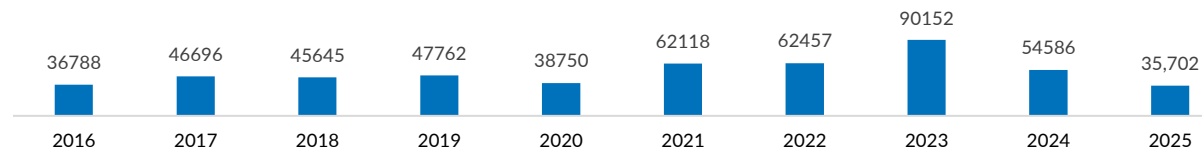

REGULATIONS

- Syrian refugees' work is regulated by Jordanian Labor Law as it applies to non-Jordanian workers.
- Syrian refugees can work in occupations open to foreigners.
- Syrian refugees can register and operate a business in food processing, artisan, and tailoring.

WORK PERMITS ISSUED IN JORDAN*

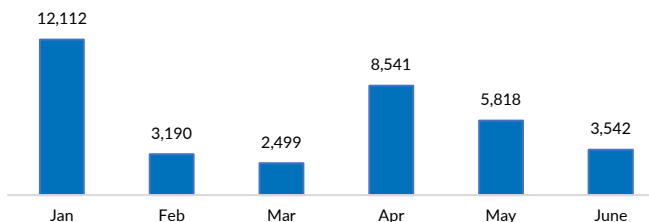
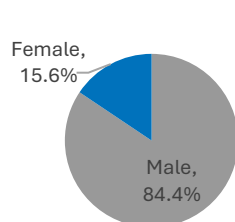

Total of **35,702** permits issued in 2025.

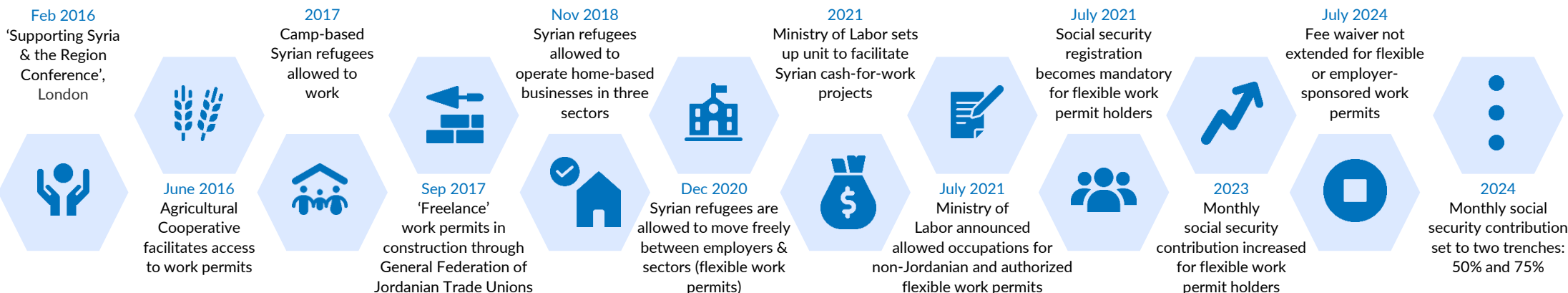


WORK PERMITS IN CAMPS

29,042 permits were self-reported to the Zaatari Office for Employment since 2017. Total number of **active work permits** in June 2025 is **723**.

4,522 permits were self-reported to the Azraq Centre for Employment since 2018. Total number of **active work permits** in July 2025 is **126**.
