
### Age Cohort







### By Country of Origin






Mainly composed of populations who fled intercommunal clashes in the Logone and Chari department in Cameroon. They are located in the two camps around N'Djamena and on the banks of the Logone River.	Outside the major nationalities, there are individuals of various origins: Algeria, Benin, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Côte d'Ivoire, Republic of the Congo, Egypt, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Gabon, Libya, Mali, Islamic Republic of Iran, Rwanda, Senegal, Somalia, South Sudan, Palestine, Yemen.
