#### National Disaster Risk Management Unit:

- Serve as the main national technical point of contact for the emergency response
- Ensure inter-agency coordination among relevant governmental institutions, UN agencies, and international partners involved in the emergency response in line with the National Response Plan
- Ensure transparency and accountability in the management and implementation of the emergency response
- Coordinate with sub-national Disaster Risk Management Committees at the governorate level to support localized response efforts
- Serve as a central hub for information management related to emergency response

#### Ministry of Social Affairs:

- Manage shelters and sites
- Coordinate assistance and protection interventions
- Coordinate with Non-Governmental Organizations (NGO)
- Lead on Internally Displaced Persons (IDP) self-registration

#### Ministry of Education and Higher Education:

- Identify shelters
- Rehabilitate infrastructure and manage buildings
- Provide additional equipment and supplies for schools
- Deliver educational and learning activities

#### Ministry of Interior and Municipalities:

- Maintain security and public order
- Support the work of governorates and local authorities
- Communicate with the public at scale
- Support rescue operations through Civil Defense

#### Ministry of Public Health:

- Manage health operations through the Public Health Emergency Operations Center
- Provide full hospital coverage for war wounded and displaced individuals
- Provide primary healthcare services and chronic & acute disease medications
- Provide mental health support
- Manage medical supply chain

#### Lebanese Red Cross:

- Support the activation of governorate operation rooms
- Facilitate IDP registration in shelters
- Monitor and track displacement movements
- Support in dedicated shelter management

#### National Council for Scientific Research:

- Document hostilities
- Assess the environmental impact of the war
- Provide early warning

#### Union of Municipalities/Municipalities:

- Support in assistance distribution
- Coordinate with shelters

#### Humanitarian Country Team:

- Provide strategic direction and leadership for the humanitarian response in Lebanon
- Endorse response priorities, plans, and resource mobilization efforts
- Support high-level advocacy and engagement with the Government and donors

#### LRP Inter-Sector Coordination Group:

- Ensure coherence across LRP sectors
- Facilitate coordination with Government counterparts and HCT
- Provide strategic guidance for the humanitarian response

#### Sector Coordination Teams:

- Coordinate sector partners and ensure alignment with national priorities
- Consolidate sector-level data, including service mapping, reporting, and monitoring
- Identify needs and gaps and feed into inter-sector coordination processes

#### LRP (Sub-national) Operational Coordination Groups:

- Facilitate operational coordination with Governors and local DRM structures
- Coordinate with sectors and partners on operational follow-up
- Escalate operational challenges, access constraints, and service gaps to national structures
