



**WEEKLY STATISTICS**





**Weekly registration: 6-12 May.-2013**

- During the current week (6 - 12 May), 233 individuals have been registered; 129 are active. With the introduction of the new GoSS resolution, 104 individuals have been registered and not provided with ration cards in Yida.
- 74 out of 233 are newborns.
- 60.38% of new arrivals are minors and 39.62% are above 18 years.
- 49.79% are female, 50.21% are male;
- Rejections:**  
**12 individuals have been rejected this week:**
  - 3 suspected AC ;
  - 8 are South Sudanese;
  - 1 Visitor.
- Transfers:**
  - 174 individuals were transferred from Yida to Ajoung Thok and 34 individuals were transferred from Pariang to Ajoung Thok. 1 individual was spontaneous arrival to Ajoung Thok. As of May 12 Ajoung Thok camp host 431 refugees.
  - Majority of new arrivals come from Heban and Al Boram.

**INACTIVATION/RE-ACTIVATION:**

- 4 individuals were inactivated during the week. They went back to Nuba.
- 1 individual has been re-activated this week.
- 0 individuals who missed verification were rejected following interviews
- 11 individuals were closed, they died.
