



**WEEKLY STATISTICS**




**Weekly registration: 20-25 May.-2013**

- ① During the current week (20 - 26 May), 171 individuals have been registered; 110 are active. With the introduction of the new GoSS resolution, 61 individuals have been registered and not provided with ration cards in Yida.
- ② 79 out of 110 are newborns.
- ③ 45% of new arrivals are minors and 55% are above 18 years.
- ④ 53.33% are female, 46.67% are male;
- ⑤ **Rejections:**  
- 0 individuals have been rejected this week.
- ⑥ **Transfers:**  
- 119 individuals were transferred from Yida to Ajourng Thok and 17 refugee Pariang students were moved from Yida to Ajourng Thok. - 15 Individuals were transferred from Yida to Nyeel and 1 individual was transferred from Pariang to Nyeel. 0 individuals spontaneously arrived to Ajourng Thok. As of May 25 Ajourng Thok camp host 980 refugees.
- ⑦ Majority of new arrivals come from Heban and Al Boram.
- INACTIVATION/RE-ACTIVATION:**  
- 42 individuals were inactivated during the week (all back to Nuba Mountains)  
- 164 individual have been re-activated this week.  
0 individuals who missed verification were rejected following interviews  
- 0 individuals were closed, they died.  
- 4 individual have been inactivated as they are active combatants.

**Cumulative statistics and trends**

- ① 71,055 individuals, 17,197 households are registered in Yida camp 63.9% are females head of household and 36.1% are males.
- ② **INACTIVATION (Cumulative):**  
- 27,436 individuals have been totally inactivated.
