



WEEKLY STATISTICS



Weekly registration: 27-May-1 June.-2013

① During the current week (1 June), 160 individuals have been registered; 117 are active. With the introduction of the new GoSS resolution, 43 individuals have been registered and not provided with ration cards in Yida.

② 73 out of 117 are newborns.

③ 45% of new arrivals are minors and 55% are above 18 years.

④ 53.33% are female, 46.67% are male;

⑤ **Rejections:**
0 individuals have been rejected this week.



⑥ **Transfers:**
- 68 individuals were transferred from Yida to Ajoung Thok and 31 individuals of Pariang were moved from Yida to Ajoung Thok. 2 individuals were re-activated, 1 individual was spontaneous arrival to Ajoung Thok. As of June 1 Ajoung Thok camp host 1082 refugees.

⑦ Majority of new arrivals come from Heban and Al Boram.

INACTIVATION/RE-ACTIVATION:

- 8 individuals were inactivated during the week, 1 individual inactivated because he is Active Combatant and 7 individuals are SSD.
- 0 individual has been re-activated this week.
- 0 individuals who missed verification were rejected following interviews
- 0 individuals were closed, they died.
