



**WEEKLY STATISTICS**





**Weekly registration: 22-27 July.-2013**

- ① During the current week (22 - 27 July), 163 individuals have been registered;
- ② 68 out of 163 are newborns.
- ③ 77.00 % of new arrivals are minors and 23.00 % are above 18 years.
- ④ 49.00 % are female, 51.00 % are male;
- ⑤ **Rejections:**  
**12 individuals have been rejected this week:**
  - 8 active combatants.
  - 0 South Sudanese.
  - 4 individuals are Darfurians who came straight forward from Darfur.
- ⑥ **Transfers:**
  - 285 individuals were transferred from Yida to Ajoung Thok and 26 individuals previously registered in Pariang were transferred to Ajoung Thok starting off from Yida. 1 Individual previously registered in Nyeel was transferred in Ajoung Thok. 1 spontaneous arrival was registered, 0 new born baby and 1 person died and closed in Ajoung thok. As of July 28 Ajoung Thok camp host 3,012 refugees.
  - ⑦ Majority of new arrivals come from Heban and Al Boram.

**INACTIVATION/RE-ACTIVATION:**

- 0 individuals were reactivated this week.
- 1 person died and closed.
- 10 individuals have been inactivated this week, they went back to nuba.
- No individuals who missed verification were rejected following interviews
