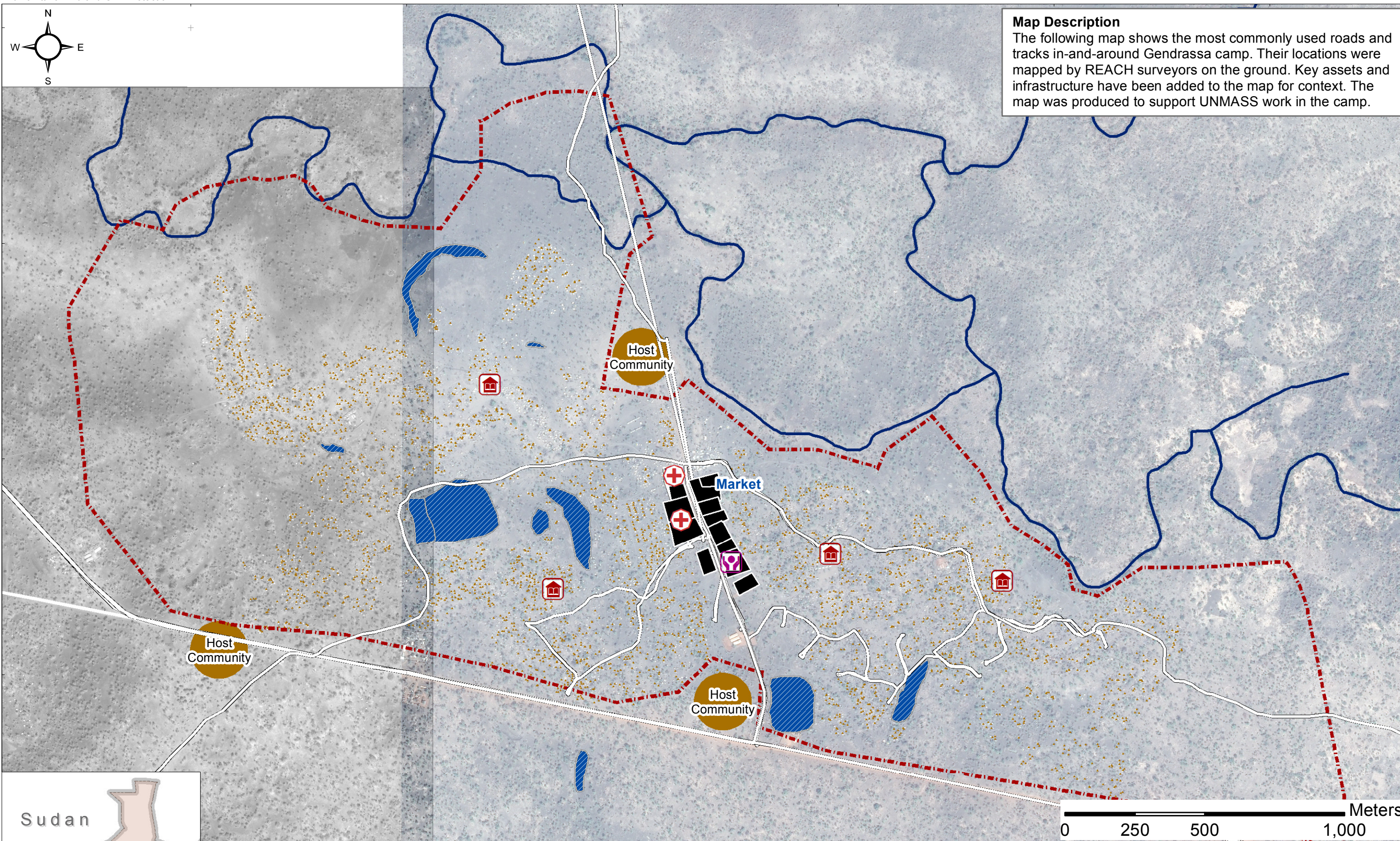




Refugee Response in Upper Nile, South Sudan
