


- As at the end of January 2014, the active camp population in Kakuma stood at **132,606 persons\***, with Somali refugees accounting for 40.65% of the total camp population, South Sudanese and Sudanese making up 36.71% and 5.96% respectively, and the remaining 16 nationalities, including those from Ethiopia, Cameroon, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Eritrea, and others accounting for the remaining 16.64% of the camp population. (\*This does not include those awaiting registration.)



### Sex/Age breakdown, by nationality



- 1,824 women were registered in January 2014, representing 50.2% of the total individuals registered during the reporting period.
- Minors (persons under the age of 18) totaled 2,518 individuals or 69.3% of the registered individuals, including 790 children between 0-4 years of age (21.7%)
- 81.9% of the newly registered individuals originated from South Sudan, while 6.1% were from Sudan. The remaining 12% were from Somalia, DRC, Burundi, Ethiopia, Rwanda, and Uganda.

## PROTECTION OVERVIEW

### Specific Protection Needs

- Out of the total registered population, 721\* specific needs were identified. (Specific needs counts do not necessarily correspond to individuals, as a single individual can have more than one specific protection need).
- Unaccompanied and separated children (USCs) remain the most commonly identified specific need, with a count of 545\* USCs identified during the reporting period (225 girls, and 320 boys).
