


A total of **42,888** new arrivals have been registered since the start of 2014; with 888 arriving from Burundi, 1 from Cameroon, 3 from Congo Brazzaville, 809 from Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), 6 from Eritrea, 469 from Ethiopia, 1 from Pakistan, 1 from Russia, 51 from Rwanda, 2 from Saudi Arabia, 1007 from Somalia, 38,206 from South Sudan, 1,349 from Sudan, 94 from Uganda and 1 from Yemen. In addition, the Sub-Office has received **804** South Sudanese 'returnees' and their records reactivated; bringing the total arrivals figure to **43,692**.

The total new born babies so far registered in 2014 is **3,236**.

21 individuals were registered during the thirty ninth week of 2014 (**21st - 27th Sept 2014**); 7 from Burundi, 2 from Ethiopia, 3 from Somalia, 7 from South Sudan and 2 from Uganda. As at 20th September 2014, the overall registered population in Kakuma Refugee Camp stands at **174,803**.

The average family size registered during the reporting period stood at **2.3** individuals. Family size 1 households represented **77.8%** of all newly registered households.

Additionally, we have so far received approximately **43,272** individuals arriving from South Sudan *en masse* as a result of the ongoing conflict.



NB: This report reflects registration trends. In addition to new arrivals reported here, the overall population in Kakuma also increases through new births, in-situ registration (of persons who arrived in a previous period but reported for registration later), family reunification, and various other data adjustments. Analysis and projections are based on actual persons registered in the UNHCR registration database (proGres)
