A total of 44,156 new arrivals have been registered since the start of 2014; with 960 arriving from Burundi, 1 from Cameroon, 5 from Congo Brazzaville, 888 from Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), 6 from Eritrea, 500 from Ethiopia, 1 from Pakistan, 1 from Russia, 60 from Rwanda, 2 from Saudi Arabia, 1144 from Somalia, 39,110 from South Sudan, 1,389 from Sudan, 96 from Uganda and 1 from Yemen. In addition, the Sub-Office has received 812 South Sudanese 'returnees' and their records reactivated; bringing the total arrivals figure to 44,968.
The total new born babies so far registered in 2014 is 3,589.
322 individuals were registered during the forty fourth week of 2014 [26th Oct - 1st Nov 2014]; 16 from Burundi, 1 from Congo Brazzaville, 14 from Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), 1 from Ethiopia, 4 from Rwanda, 46 from Somalia, 237 from South Sudan, and 3 from Sudan. As at 31st Oct 2014, the overall registered population in Kakuma Refugee Camp stands at 176,279.
The average family size registered during the reporting period stood at 3.0 individuals. Family size 1 households represented 40.6% of all newly registered households.



NB: This report reflects registration trends. In addition to new arrivals reported here, the overall population in Kakuma also increases through new births, in-situ registration (of persons who arrived in a previous period but reported for registration later), family reunification, and various other data adjustments. Analysis and projections are based on actual persons registered in the UNHCR registration database (proGres)
