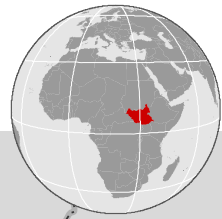


# SOUTH SUDAN EMERGENCY : Areas of origin (States) of South Sudanese refugees in Ethiopia, Uganda and Kenya

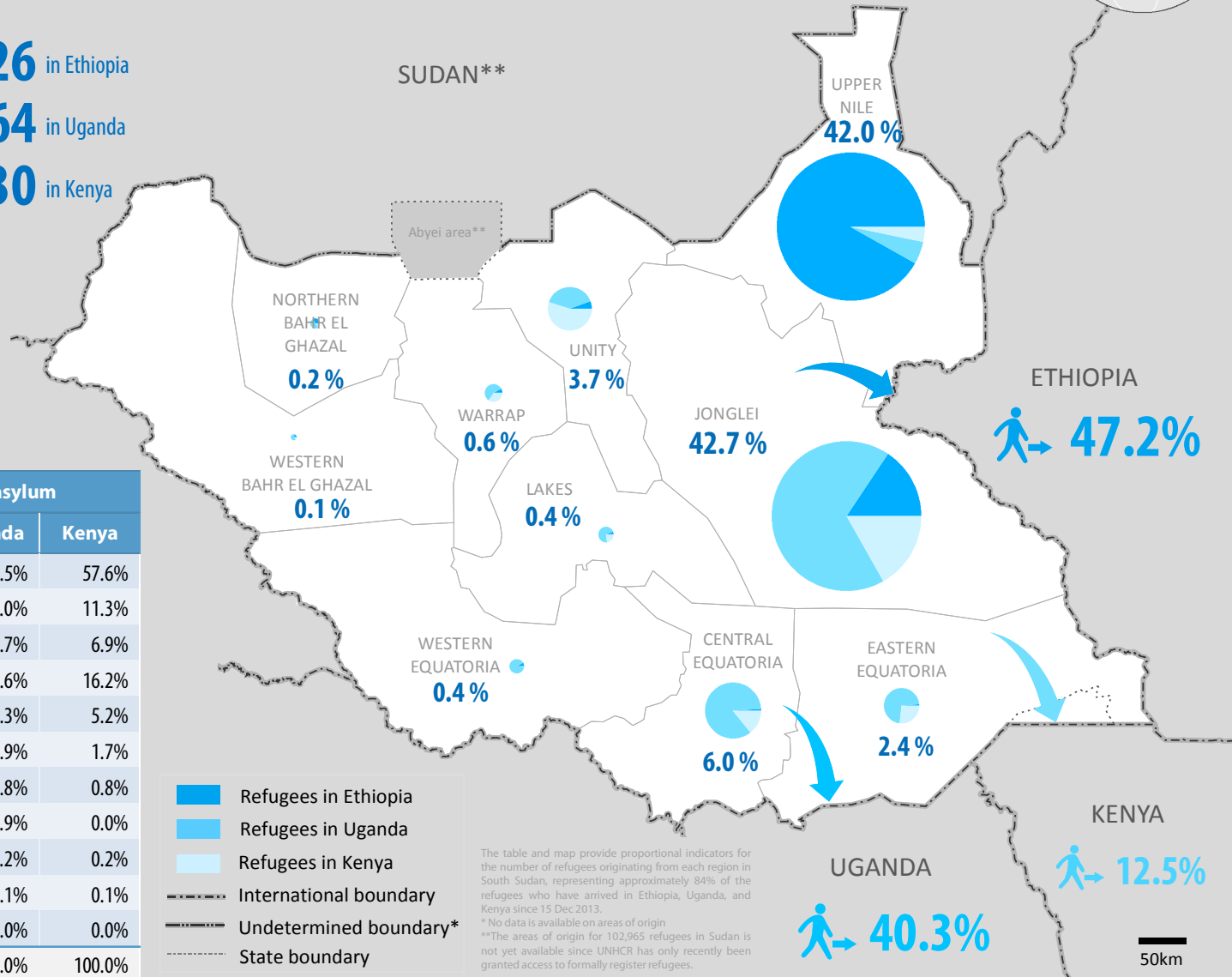
