

# SUDAN: Arrivals from South Sudan | 15 December 2013 - 14 January 2015










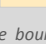
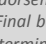
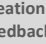
Over **119,945** persons have arrived in Sudan from South Sudan

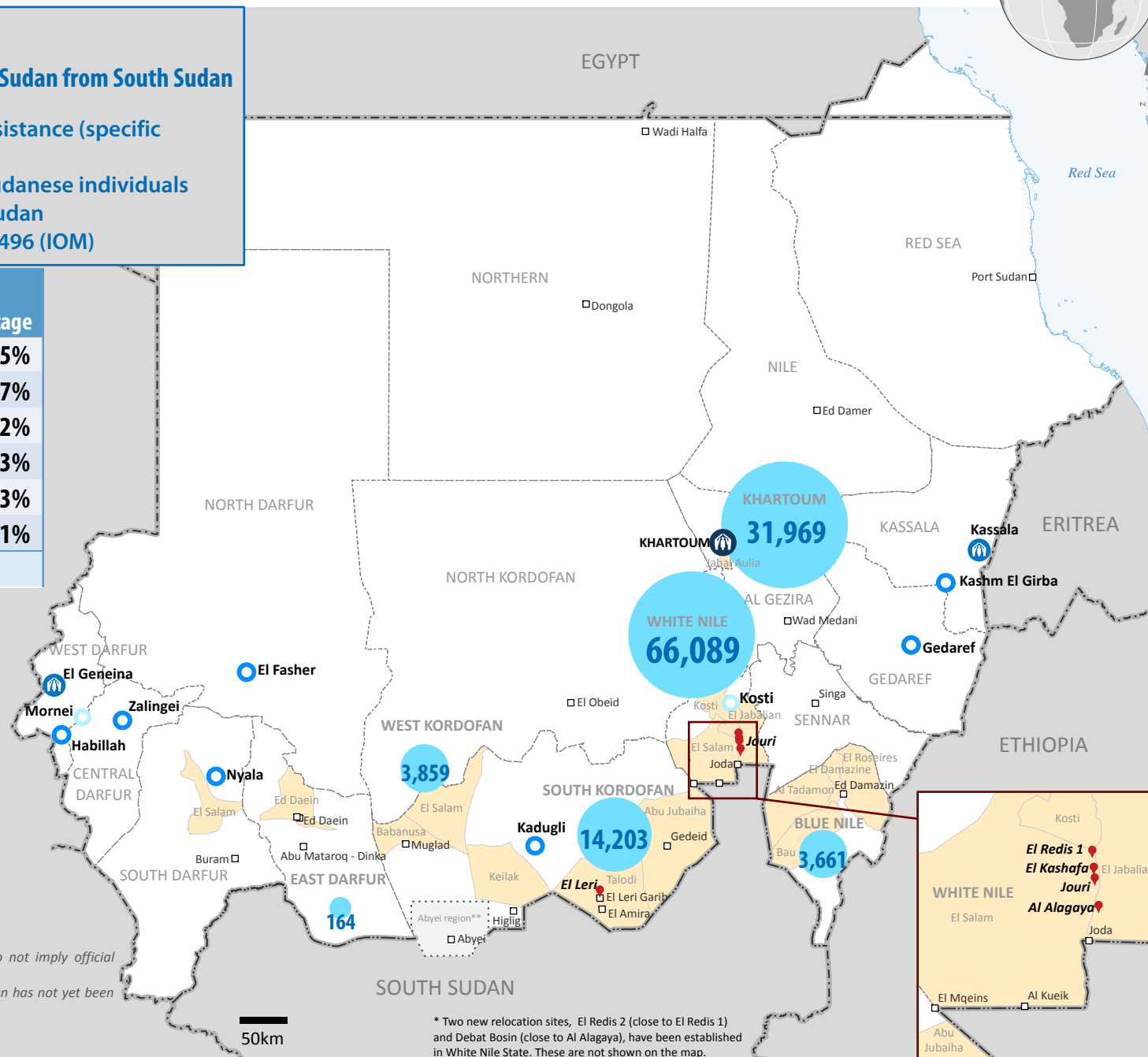
