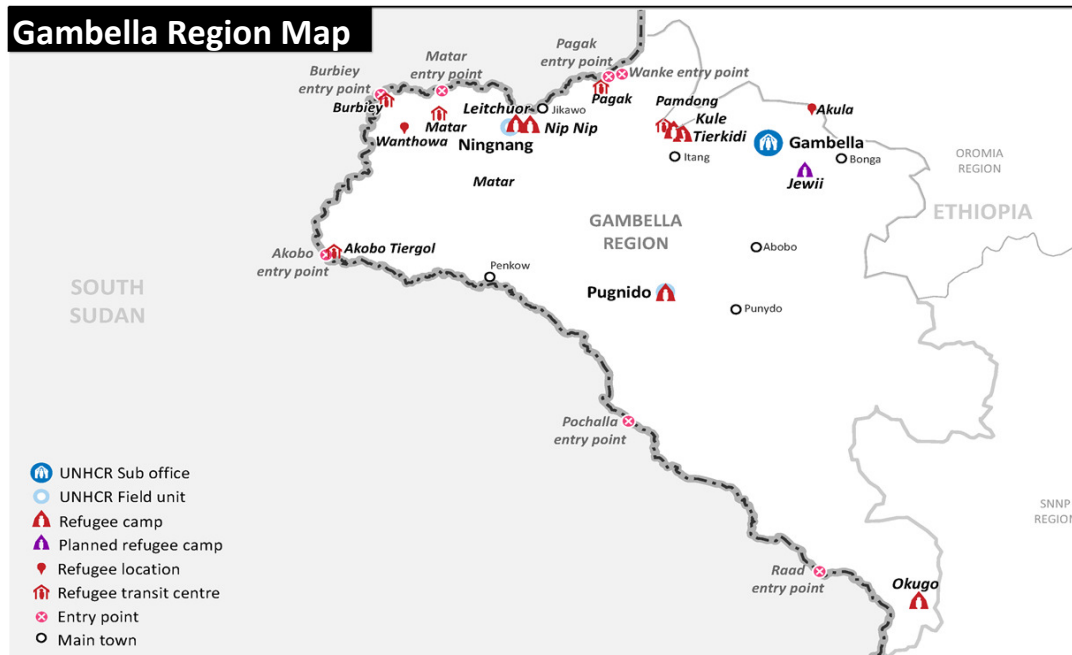


# South Sudanese new arrivals in Gambella - Post 15<sup>th</sup> December 2013 (as of 05-May-2015)

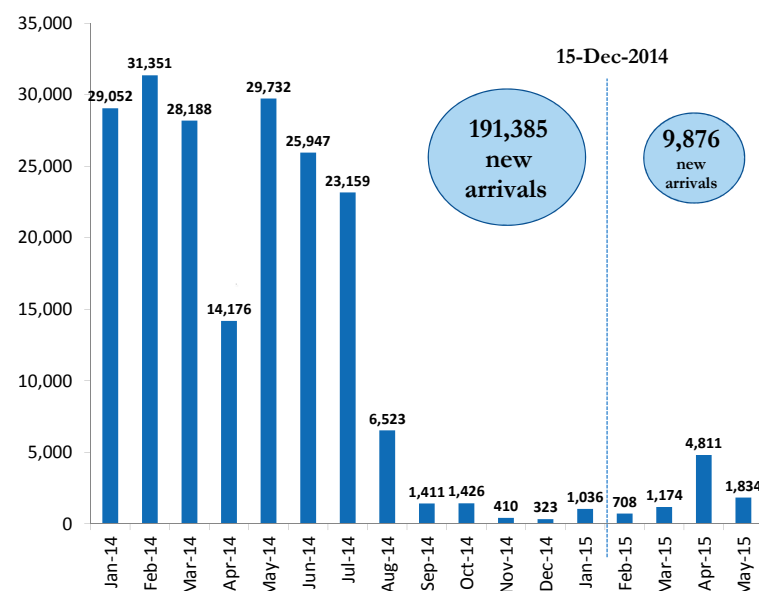
