






New arrivals, by sex and COO



New arrivals, by sex and COO




New arrivals, breakdown by age




Notes: Dadaab refugee camps continue to receive a significant number of new arrivals. A total of 120,224 have been registered since the start of this Year with 118,627 individuals arriving from Somalia, 1,392 from Ethiopia, 174 from Sudan, 15 from the Democratic Republic of Congo, 4 from Burundi, 6 from Uganda, 1 from Eritrea, 1 from Côte d'Ivoire and 4 from Rwanda. 5,287 individuals have been registered during the week of 29th August - 4th September of this Year, with 5,208 arriving from Somalia, 62 from Ethiopia and 17 from Sudan.

As of 4th September 2011, the overall population in the Dadaab camps stood at 428,574 persons. The average family size registered during the reporting period stood at 3 individuals. Family size 1 households represented 36% of all newly registered households.

NB: This report reflects registration trends. In addition to new arrivals reported here, the overall population in Dadaab also increases through new births, in-situ registration (of persons who arrived in a previous period but reported for registration later), family reunification, and various other data adjustments. Analysis and projections are based on actual persons registered in the UNHCR registration database (proGres)
