








Areas Receiving IDPs





Correlation of IDPs



Between 1 December and 10 February 2012, displacements were mainly recorded in South Central with approximately 56,000 out of 61,000 displacements recorded in all three regions. 25,000 displaced people reported Insecurity as the major cause of displacement in South Central followed by IDP return (14,000), Refugee return (9,400), lack of livelihood (4,400) and Eviction (1,300). The displacements originated mainly from Shabelle Hoose (12,000), Hiraan (10,000), Mogadishu (9,200) and Juba Hoose (5,300) regions. The IDPs moved to Mogadishu (21,000), Gedo (11,000), Hiraan (9,500) among other regions.

This data has been collected through the IASC Population Movement Tracking (PMT) system. PMT is designed to capture population movement trends, not cumulative population data. Due to the fluid nature of displacement in Somalia and in order to avoid capturing multiple displacements, UNHCR limits the reporting range to a period of three months - these figures should therefore not be added and used cumulatively.
