Notes: A total of **11,781** new arrivals have been registered since the start of 2012; with 875 arriving from Burundi, 573 from Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), 5 from Eritrea, 648 from Ethiopia, 1 from Iran, 1 from Ivory Coast, 53 from Rwanda, 640 from Somalia, 7,398 from South Sudan, 1,472 from Sudan, 2 from Tanzania and 113 from Uganda.

174 individuals were registered during the Twenty-Eighth week of 2012 [**16th-20th July 2012**]; 22 from Burundi, 5 from Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), 31 from Ethiopia, 1 from Rwanda, 20 from Somalia, 78 from South Sudan, 9 from Sudan and 8 from Uganda. As at 20th July 2012, the overall population in Kakuma Refugee Camp stood at **99,631**.

The average family size registered during the reporting period stood at **2.2** individuals. Family size **1** households represented **65.3%** of all newly registered households.

As at 20th July 2012, the total South Sudanese 'returnee' figure stands at **273** individuals; mainly from Jonglei, Equatoria and Bahr el Ghazal States.

Additionally, the total new births recorded since January 2012 is **1,533**.

NB: This report reflects registration trends. In addition to new arrivals reported here, the overall population in Kakuma also increases through new births, in-situ registration (of persons who arrived in a previous period but reported for registration later), family reunification, and various other data adjustments. Analysis and projections are based on actual persons registered in the UNHCR registration database (proGres)
