

## I. Political, Security, Social and Economic Situation

The situation remains calm in all the camps. On the 14<sup>th</sup> of January, Niger declared the alert state in the area of north Tillabery, north Tahoua and all the Agadez area.

In Tillabery, the security forces of Tabareybarey camp have patrolled all night to ensure the security of the camp. Tillabery authorities are closely monitoring the entrance into the country of vehicles from Mali. As of today, one of UNHCR's implementing partners used armed escort to go to the camp.

In Abala area, security situation permitting, UNHCR is planning a border monitoring mission in Chinegodrar from 16 January 2013 to evaluate the situation at the border. In Mangaize, the situation remains calm but the Nigerien army is increasing its presence in the area.

## II. Daily highlight

### Trends of arrival

Teams from the field have reported no new arrival today in Niger refugee camps and sites.
