



**United Nations Country Team in Turkey
Daily Situation Report on the Situation Pertaining to Syria**

April 14-15, 2012

It has been reported in the website of AFAD (Disaster and Emergency Management Presidency, Turkey's umbrella structure in charge of government's operations for Syrians) that as of April 14, 2012 total camp population is reached to **23,971** persons

April 13, 2012

Arrivals: 43 persons


Returns: 9 persons

April 14, 2012

Arrivals: 67 persons

Returns: 449 persons

Increase in the arrivals from December 16, 2011 to April 14, 2012 is reflected below.



Currently arrivals from Syria are assisted in the border provinces of Hatay, Gaziantep, Kilis and Şanlıurfa.

As of April 14, 2012 the city breakdown in the region is as follows:


- Hatay population* : 7,277 individuals
- Gaziantep population in Islahiye† : 5,787 individuals.

* : The population of the Kuyubaşı/Karbeyaz, Yayladağı 2 (YİBO), Altınözü I (TEKEL) and Reyhanlı camps in Hatay is moved to Islahiye camp in Gaziantep and to Öncüpınar container site in Kilis. It has been reported that these empty camps will be kept for while as standby and there is some use of these camps for new arrivals.

† : There are two locations in Islahiye; Nurdagi Sport Center and Islahiye tent city but population figure is for all.

- Kilis population in Öncüpınar container site: 9,207 individuals
- Şanlıurfa population in Ceylanpınar: 1,626 individuals

Population movement from Hatay to Gaziantep (Islahiye Camp), Kilis (Öncüpınar Container site) and Şanlıurfa (Ceylanpınar), from March 15[‡] to April 14, 2012 is reflected below.

1. Highlights:

- ❖ The Government of Turkey has advised UNHCR that it is willing to accept offers of international assistance, and has outlined the specific items which will be accepted. The total donations for the Syria situation to date are 5,100 family tents, 10,000 bed mats, and almost 34,000 blankets. This includes last year's donation from UNHCR directed initially to the Syria response but then redirected to the earthquake in Van.

[‡] 15 March is the date of first movement took place from Hatay.

- ❖ It has been reported in the local daily newspaper **Kent** on April 13, 2012 that UNHCR donated 1,600 tents and 13,860 blankets to Kızılay (Turkish Red Crescent). The tents will be used in Hatay as needed.

- iii. Total numbers of refugees ex-Syria who have approached UNHCR in Turkey

Iraqis: 796 cases / 1692 persons

Others: 70 cases / 89 persons
