

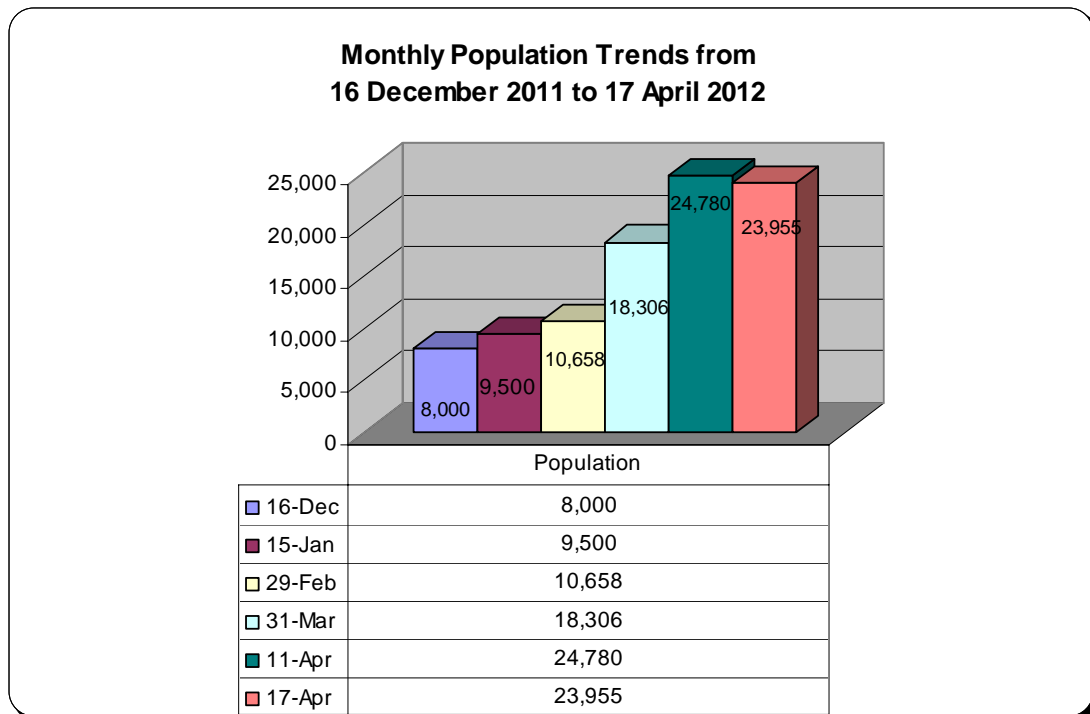


**United Nations Country Team in Turkey**  
**Daily Situation Report on the Situation Pertaining to Syria**

**April 17, 2012**

It has been reported officially that as of April 17, 2012 total camp population is **23,955** persons with the arrival of 129 and return of 176 persons on April 16-17, 2012.

Population trends from December 16, 2011 to April 17, 2012 is reflected below.



Currently arrivals from Syria are assisted in the border provinces of Hatay, Gaziantep, Kilis and Şanlıurfa.

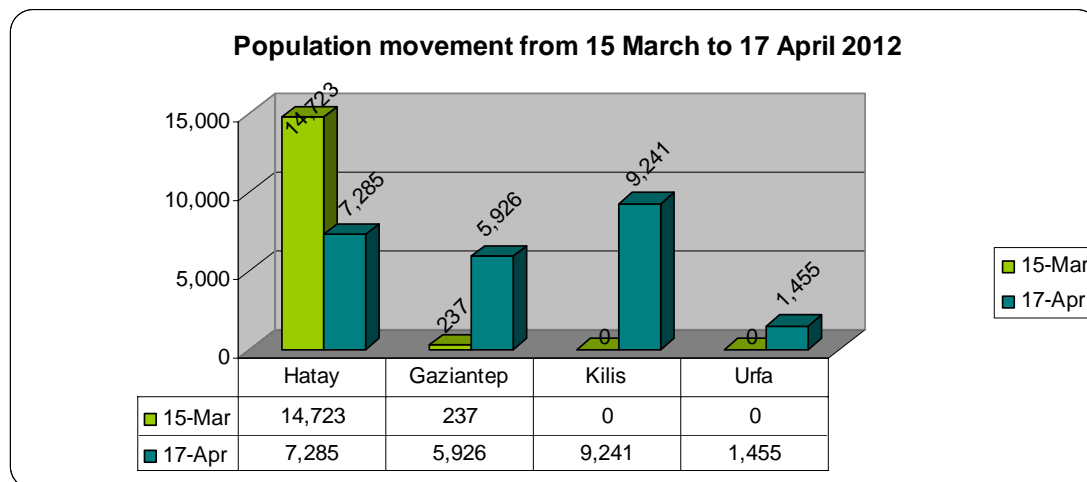
As of April 17, 2012 the city breakdown in the region is as follows:

- Hatay population<sup>\*</sup> : 7,285 individuals
- Gaziantep population in İslahiye<sup>†</sup>: 5,926 individuals.
- Kilis population in Öncüpınar container site: 9,241 individuals
- Şanlıurfa population in Ceylanpınar: 1,455 individuals

<sup>\*</sup> : The population of the Kuyubaşı/Karbeyaz, Yayladağı 2 (YİBO), Altınözü I (TEKEL) and Reyhanlı camps in Hatay is moved to İslahiye camp in Gaziantep and to Öncüpınar container site in Kilis. It has been reported that these empty camps will be kept for while as standby and there is some use of these camps for new arrivals.

<sup>†</sup> : There are two locations in İslahiye; Nurdağı Sport Center and İslahiye tent city but population figure is for all.

Population movement from Hatay to Gaziantep (Islahiye Camp), Kilis (Öncüpınar Container site) and Şanlıurfa (Ceylanpınar), from March 15<sup>†</sup> to April 17, 2012 is reflected below.

- ❖ It has been reported in the daily **Kent** that 14 persons arrived in Hatay through Yayladağı.
- ❖ It was also reported in the local daily newspaper **Kırkasır** that authorities are digging a well for water to be in used in the Boynuyoğun camp.
