

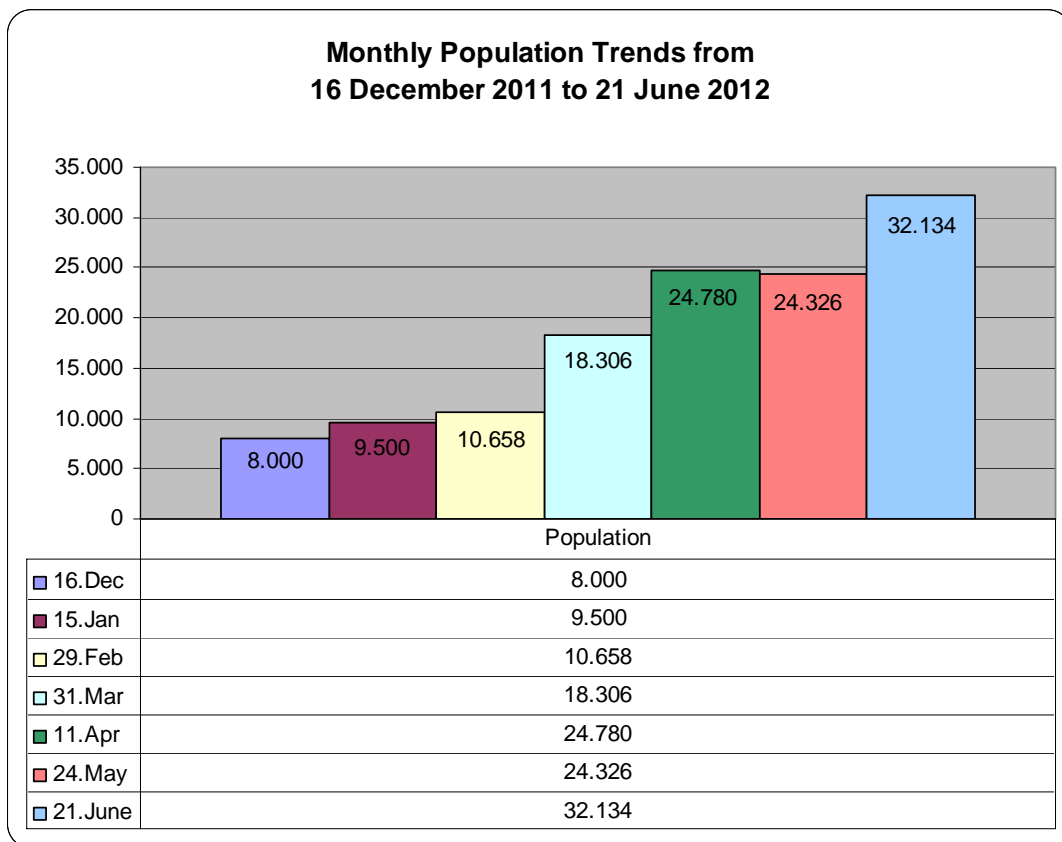

Daily Situation Report on the Situation Pertaining to Syria

June 21, 2012

It has been reported officially that as of June 21, 2012 total camp population is reached to **32,134** with the arrival of 361 and return of 74 persons on June 20-21, 2012.

The total number of registered persons from December 16, 2011 to June 21, 2012 is reflected below.

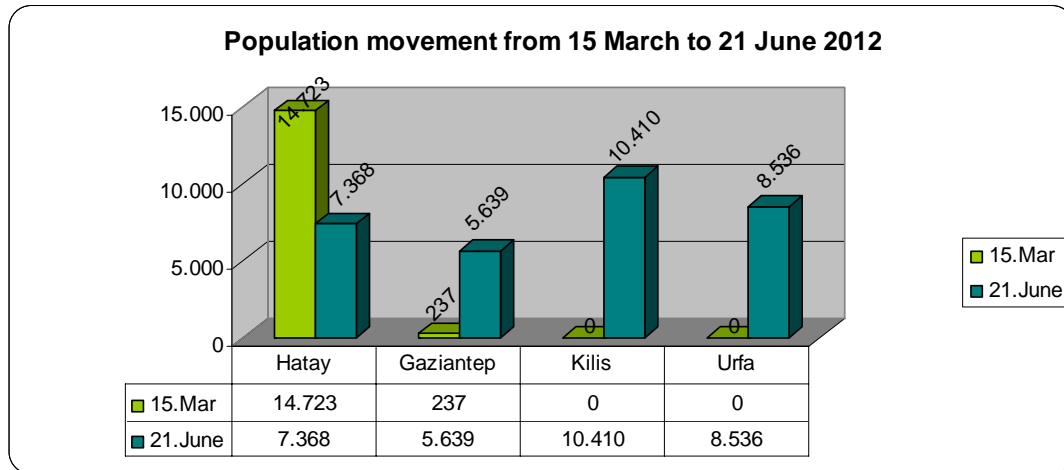


Currently arrivals from Syria are assisted in the border provinces of Hatay, Gaziantep, Kilis and Şanlıurfa.

As of June 21, 2012 the city breakdown in the region is as follows:

- Hatay population* : 7,368 individuals
- Gaziantep population in Islahiye†: 5,639 individuals
- Kilis population in Öncüpınar container site: 10,410 individuals
- Şanlıurfa population in Ceylanpınar: 8,536 individuals

Population movement from Hatay to Gaziantep (Islahiye Camp), Kilis (Öncüpınar Container site) and Şanlıurfa (Ceylanpınar), from 15 March† to 21 June 2012 is reflected below.



Please find below the map of the region including current 10 camps in Hatay, Kilis, Gaziantep and Şanlıurfa as of June 21, 2012.



1. Highlights:

*: The population of the Kuyubaşı/Karbeyaz, Yayladağı 2 (YİBO) and Reyhanlı camps in Hatay is moved to Islahiye camp in Gaziantep and to Öncüpınar container site in Kilis. It has been reported that these empty camps will be kept for while as standby and there is some use of these camps for new arrivals.

† 15 March is the date of first movement took place from Hatay.

- ❖ A remarkable increase was observed in the arrivals as the population is increased to 32,314 persons. Ceylanpınar camp population is increased more than 50% since June 11, 2012.
- ❖ Newly arrived persons are being transferred to the Ceylanpınar Camp in Şanlıurfa and the current population of the camp is reached to 8,536 persons since the capacity of the camps in Kilis and Gaziantep is almost full.
