


Highlights

- On September 5, 2012, the Government of Turkey officially reported that the number of Syrians registered and accommodated in the camps including those temporarily placed in the schools as well as the ones under medical treatment in the hospitals is 78,431 persons.
- According to the officials during the period of August 31 -September 4, 2,747 persons have returned to Syria voluntarily and 1,038 persons have been admitted and placed in various camps.
- UNHCR was informed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Regional Representative, that as of September 5, 2012 there was about 10,200 persons across the borders of Kilis and Hatay, waiting to be admitted. The authorities informed that the border is not closed and they will be accepted gradually and placed in the newly opened in Gaziantep-Karkamış and Kahramanmaraş. It is expected that by mid September all those in the schools will be transferred to the camps.
- The priority will continue to be given to the relocation of those who are still in the schools and the ones across the border will
