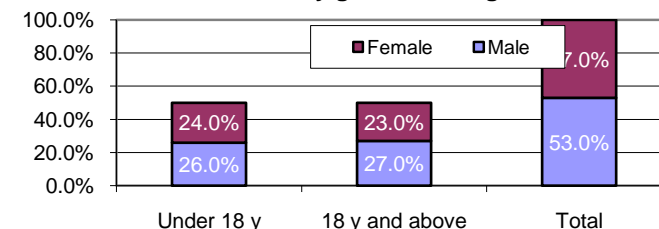

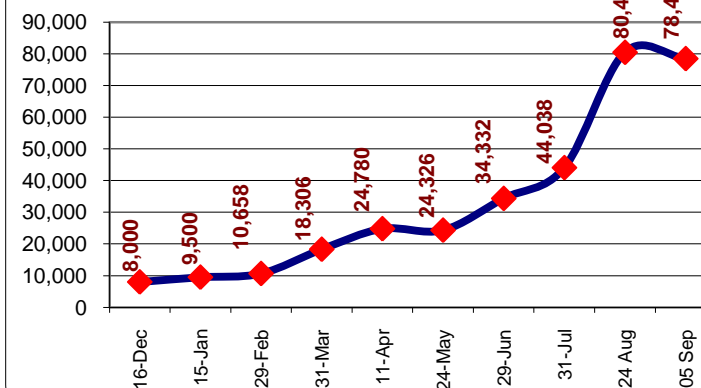
Highlights

- The Government of Turkey did not report any new official figures of Syrians since September 5, 2012 however unofficial figures is estimated to be around 80,000 people.
- According to the information from the local authorities (MFA and AFAD), about 419 new arrivals were admitted and transferred to the camps and 202 Syrians have returned to Syria voluntarily during the 24 hrs of September 6-7, 2012.
- Reportedly there are no new arrivals kept at the border on the Turkish side however based on the number of commissaries provided by the Turkish Red Crescent on a daily basis, the number of Syrians waiting across the borders of both Hatay and Kilis is estimated to be around 10,000.
- According to the authorities the borders are open despite the admission process is slow. Some of the local authorities assumption is that not all of these 10,000 people across the border might be willing to cross to Turkish side but would like to benefit from the assistance delivered at the border.
