


## Highlights

- On September 18, 2012, the Turkish Government officially reported that the total number of Syrians accommodated in the camps as well as those who are under medical treatment in various hospitals reached to **83,260** persons.
- Reportedly during the 24 hrs of September 17-18, 2012, 608 persons were admitted from the borders and 124 persons have returned to Syrian voluntarily.
- According to the Regional Representative of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the borders are open and the Syrians who seek temporary protection are admitted gradually in groups and placed in the camps however the process is slow due to proceedings at the border.
- According to Turkish Government Agency (AFAD) the construction of four camps - two in Gaziantep Nizip, one in Şanlıurfa-Akçakale and one in Adıyaman, is on going and they are expected to be gradually opened until the end of September 2012.
- UN and Arab League Special Envoy Mr Al-Akhdar Al-Ibrahimi, visited Hatay, met with the local authorities and Syrian Refugees in Altınözü-one Camp in Hatay on September 18, 2012.
