

Highlights


- No new official figures reported by the Government of Turkey since October 5, 2012. Local authorities (Ministry of Foreign Affairs, MFA) informed that the total number of Syrians reached over 99,000. According to AFAD (Disaster and Emergency Management Presidency) the number of Syrians registered and accommodated in the camps including those undertaking medical treatment is **99,082** persons as of October 9, 2012.
- Reportedly during the 24 hrs of 08-09 October 2012, 506 Syrians newly admitted from the borders, registered and accommodated in the camps while 167 Syrians have returned to Syria voluntarily.
- According to MFA Regional Representative, the number Syrians across the border is still estimated to be about 14,000 despite the admissions gradually in smaller groups. Reportedly the numbers are based on food packages delivered at zero point of the border by the Turkish Red Crescent based on the requests from the local community leaders across the borders.
- UNHCR and UNICEF joint mission visited Kilis Öncüpınar container site and Gaziantep Islahiye camp, met with the authorities and observed the education needs for the Syrian children in the camps which will be further discussed with the Turkish Government at central level.
