





Age & Gender of Registered Syrian Refugees



Highlights

- On 23 September 2013, AFAD - the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Government of Turkey - announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in 21 camps in 10 provinces was 200,011, including 651 Syrians receiving medical treatment in hospitals. AFAD reported that during the 24 hrs of 22-23 Sept. 2013, a total of 444 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 438 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- UNHCR continues to advocate with camp officials for refugee participation in camp management. Adana Saricam camp officials informed the UNHCR Field Team that they having some challenges with the elected refugee representatives, and are therefore considering replacing some of them. In Mardin Midyat camp a Women's Committee has been established with 10 women. A similar structure called the "advisory council", consisting of 14 women and 12 men, was also established in Kilis Elbeyli container site. UNHCR also suggested that camp management consider establishing a youth committee and has recommended the committee in Harran as a good practice.
- In Mardin, camp officials informed UNHCR that the construction of the transit center in Nusaybin is on-going. The intended capacity will be for 20,000 persons. In Mardin local officials also informed the UNHCR Field Team that the number of Syrians approaching the police spontaneously to request facilitation of their safe crossing to voluntarily return to Syria is still about 300-500 daily. In order to minimize the logistical needs (transportation, etc.) officials are working on establishing a center in the Senyurt border town of Mardin, near Kiziltepe, where there is a secure military crossing point.
- In Adana Saricam camp, officials informed that the Foundation for the promotion of Vocational Training and Small Industry, which is supporting the vocational courses (air conditioner maintenance and electrical items etc.), is considering the provision of advanced training to 28 elected graduates of the course in their center in Adana city. As a recreational activity, the camp officials are also planning to organize a table tennis tournament in the city involving 16 selected children from the camp.
- The Adana Saricam camp manager requested the UNHCR Field team to invite the Field representatives of UN Agencies (UNHCR, WFP, UNICEF, UNFPA etc.) working in Field to discuss their activities and areas of
